CITY COUNCIL TOUR

Mayor Weese called the August 26, 2008 City Council Tour to order at 6:00 p.m. The Council met at 102 South Tremont Street, Tremonton, Utah. In attendance were Mayor Max Weese, Councilmembers Reese, Wood and Fridal, Manager Woodworth, Director Marion Layne, Police Chief David Nance and Recorder Hess. Councilmembers Holmgren and Deakin were excused from the tour.

1. Approval of agenda

The agenda was approved by consensus.

2. Tour old Senior Building - open to the City Council and Press only due to safety reasons by assuming your own responsibility.

The group toured the old Senior Building. They were asked to list any items they felt would be salvageable or that could be utilized by City Departments and staff. Items listed were: Kitchen cabinets, stove, carpet in the Women's Civic and Lion's Club Rooms, six gas furnaces, decorative heater registers, four air-conditioning units, kitchen lights/fans, possible copper wiring, one water heater, one water softener and salt located in the basement, one sink in the kitchen used for hand washing, four sinks in the restroom, restroom stalls, a picnic table, a swamp cooler, large table that Melissa Lewis from BRAG has asked about. The Council discussed salvaging the wiring. This will be discussed at the next City Council Meeting. The problem with dismantling salvaging items is the insurance liability involved.

Director Layne informed the Council that there were chairs and tables under the stage as well as other items in the building that the Senior Center needs to take and there are items

(bins and two boxes) upstairs that need to be given to the Museum Committee. Department Heads are to check for items they could use.

3. Tour of the new Food Pantry Building

The group then went to the new Food Pantry Facility and took a tour of the building. Director Kathy Newman told the Council that she is delighted with the facility and the amount of space now available for the program. The Council commented that the food supply was getting really low.

Councilmember Deakin came to the meeting at 6:54 p.m. from the Planning Commission Meeting.

Some of the Council went back into the old Senior Center building to look at the items the group had listed as surplus.

4. Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned by consensus at 7:15 p.m.
