

**TREMONTON CITY  
CITY COUNCIL CANVASS OF THE 2007 GENERAL ELECTION  
November 20, 2007**

The Tremonton City Council met in the Tremonton City Council Room at 102 South Tremont, Tremonton, Utah at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, November 20, 2007 to conduct an Official Canvass of the 2007 Tremonton City Municipal Election pursuant to Utah Code 20A-4-304. The following were present at the meeting: Mayor Max Weese, Councilmembers Deakin, Reese, Stokes and Wood, and Darlene S. Hess, City Recorder.

Mayor Weese turned the time over to City Recorder, Darlene Hess, to conduct the canvass. A cursory review of the ballot tabulations was made. The results of the canvass are attached.

Recorder Hess stated that there were 2849 registered voters in the combined precincts. A total of 1384 ballots were cast or 48.58% of the registered voters voted in the 2007 Election. 57 Provisional Ballots were cast with 26 being counted. Of the 31 not counted, 28 voters were not registered, 1 ballot was incomplete and 2 were in the wrong precinct. 7 absentee ballots were mailed. Of the 7 absentee ballots mailed, 6 were postmarked in a timely manner and 1 was not counted. There were 149 voters who voted during the early voting period. 134 at Tremonton City and 15 who voted at Box Elder County or a total of 10.7%. Of the voters who early voted, 24 were from the unincorporated area. On Referendum 1, 1370 votes were cast. 14 voters did not vote for this item. On the Box Elder School District Proposition, 1371 votes were cast. 13 voters did not vote for this item. Tremonton City Council declares Referendum 1 as defeated and Box Elder School District Proposition as approved.

Recorder Hess reviewed the votes cast for the three City Council four year term positions. Byron P. Wood, Jeff Reese and Roger G. Fridal were declared as receiving the highest number of votes for the 2007 Election.

Councilmember Holmgren came to the meeting at 5:49 p.m.

Manager Woodworth came to the meeting at 5:50 p.m.

Mayor Weese called for a motion to declare the outcome of the 2007 Election Returns. **Motion by Councilmember Reese to approve the results of the 2007 Canvass of Election Returns.** Second by Councilmember Deakin. Vote: Councilmember Deakin - aye, Councilmember Wood - aye, Councilmember Reese - aye, Councilmember Stokes - aye, Councilmember Holmgren - aye. Motion unanimously approved.

The City Council Canvass of the 2007 General Election adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
