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19 Location: Intersection of Elk Ridge Drive & Gladstan Drive

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21 At 5 pm, Gavin and his assistant explained the features on the jet (vacuum) truck. The demonstration included
22 cleaning out two sumps and a curb drain, all of which were clogged with mud and debris and held water. The
23 truck's large tank was dumped three times. By about 7:30 pm, the sumps and drain were cleaned and the
24 demonstration ended.

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26 We noted that if the truck would have had a hydro pack (a larger water pressure hose) to cut through and stir
27 up the mud to make vacuuming easier, the job could have been done in much less time. However, the truck
28 proved its value even with the small water pressure hose and re-vitalized the sumps and curb drain. The value
29 of having such a truck in our equipment inventory became obvious when considering the fact that we spend
30 \$15k per year to clean one-third of our sewer lines and a few sumps. With a truck at our disposal, we could
31 work our way through all of the numerous sumps and drains throughout the city and minimize the drainage
32 problems we currently have with large amounts of runoff. Because we have so many sumps (in lieu of storm
33 drains) and that they cost about \$15k each, cleaning and re-vitalizing them is the economical thing to do.

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35 Corbett will fill the sumps with water and evaluate the effectiveness of the cleaning by noting how long it takes
36 water to percolate into the ground.

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38 We thanked the AG Truck team for their demonstration, and they are available to answer any questions we
39 may have as we consider the value of such a truck to Elk Ridge City.
