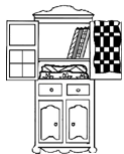

- Great new stitchery patterns from Bareroots and Buttermilk Basin

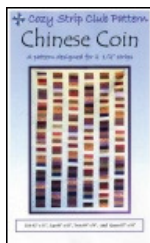




QUILTER'S CUPBOARD CLASSES AND CLUBS

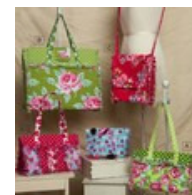

Each quilt in this series represents a major battle of the American Civil War from 1861 through 1865. Patterns include directions and measurements for 5" and 10" block sizes, so you can sew a small wall/lap size or a large bed size quilt by simply changing the size of the block. Also included in every pattern is a short historical note about the battle and a fictional letter from the battlefield - a fun way to learn a little more about our country's history and the hardships of war. We meet at the shop on the 3rd Thursday of each month for Show and Tell, a program and social time. Meeting times are 10:30 and 6:00.



Sylvia's Bridal Sampler

It's not too late to join this fun club, the 2nd session starts in July. Each month we will make 7 blocks from Jennifer Chiaverini's book *Sylvia's Bridal Sampler from Elm Creek Quilts*. After 4 five month sessions, you will have all
