Panel Play Tunic #1908

This pattern is intended for the personal use of consumers. Commercial use is prohibited without consent of Lorraine Torrence.

SIZES: XS - Bust 31"-33", Hip 31"-33"; S - Bust 34"-36", Hip 34"-37"; M - Bust 37"-39", Hip 38"-41"; L - Bust 40"-43", Hip 42"-46"; XL - Bust 44"-47", Hip 47"-50".

SUGGESTED FABRICS: **Panel Area:** Light to medium weight cottons; medium weight silks such as pongee, broadcloth, shantung, light weight wools. **Main body of vest:** Silks, linen, medium weight cottons, velveteen, light weight wool, medium weight rayons. **Foundation:** Muslin. **Lining:** Light weight silk, polyester or rayon lining fabric.

MATERIALS:

For panel as in photo: 6-7 different fabrics, ¼ yd. 45" wide of each. For a panel of a single fabric: All sizes- 5/8 yard 45" wide fabric if cut across the grain, 1 ¼ yard if cut lengthwise, 1 yd. of seamed at the shoulder. **Note: The panel may be filled with piecing, appliqué, threadwork, beading, etc. Instructions are given only for the wavy line version shown on the cover or a plain (single fabric) panel.** For panel border - 1/4 yard (not a fat quarter) of 45" wide fabric. (I use the same fabric as one of the panel fabrics for the panel border.) For foundation - XS-L, 1 ¾ yards 45" wide muslin (pre-shrink before using); XL, 2 yards 45" wide muslin, preshrunk. For main body of vest - XS, 1 yard any width; S-L, 1 1/3 yard 45" wide, or 1 yard 54"-60" wide fabric; XL, 1 5/8 yard 45" wide fabric, or 1 yard 54"-60" without nap.

For lining -

XS-L, 1 3/4 yards 45" wide lining fabric, XL, 2 yards 45" wide fabric.

For interfacing -

1/4 yard 45" wide light weight fusible (Touch of Gold is good)

Other materials and supplies -

Thread, all purpose, the colors of the main body of vest, lining.

Thread, decorative rayon or other topstitching, the color of the panel border.

1 - 6 buttons - about 5/8" - 3/4" if you are using 3-6 buttons; up to 2" button for 1.

Rotary cutter, cutting mat (17" x 23" min.),

6" x 24" cutting ruler, Extra fine permanent Sharpie pen.

Note: For stitching on tightly woven silks, #90 Sharp

Microtex machine needles are recommended. Use #100 needles for heavy weight topstitching thread..
