

## VICTORIAN WAISTCOAT #1504

**SUGGESTED FABRICS:** **Outside shell:** Light to medium weight cottons; medium weight silks such as pongee, dupioni, broadcloth, shantung; linen; lightweight wool. **Lining:** Light weight silk, polyester or rayon lining.

**Inner layer:** optional, but a muslin foundation (preshrunk) will stabilize lightweight fabrics. **Fabric for button loops:** Coordinating fabric compatible with body fabric. (You only need 1" x 36" for the loops.)

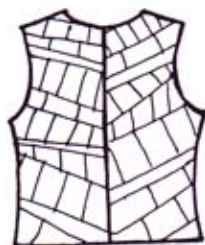
Misses	Sizes	Foundation, and lining	Fabric for Piecing	Loops
XS - Bust 32-34"	4-6	11/8 yard each, 45" wide	12 fat 1/8ths	1 fat 1/16th
S - Bust 35-38"	8-10	1 1/8 yard each, "	12 fat 1/8ths	1 fat 1/16th
M - Bust 39-41"	12-14	1 1/4 yard each, "	12 fat 1/8ths	1 fat 1/16th
L - Bust 42-45"	16-18	1 1/4 yd each, "	12 fat 1/8ths	1 fat 1/16th
XL - Bust 46-48"	20-22	1 1/2 yd each, "	12 fat 1/8ths	1 fat 1/16th

**Notions:** 14 - 1/2" to 3/4" buttons with shanks.

Thread for quilting: depending on your fabrics, choose rayon, metallic, variegated, embroidery thread, etc. For quilting you will need a walking foot for straight-line quilting or a darning foot with dropped feed dogs for free motion quilting.

**Optional:** For a crazy quilt look you may want to use rayon machine embroidery thread in a variety of colors, beads, buttons, lace etc.

Interfacing: Use lightweight fusible interfacing to "equalize" fabric weights and stabilize individual fabrics if necessary.



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
