## Two Donation Options

### I. The East Central Council of Governments (ECCOG) Enterprise Zone:

The City of Burlington Economic Development Board is an Enterprise Zone project with ECCOG. If you choose to make a cash donation (of \$250 or more) through the Enterprise Zone, you will receive 25% of your gift as a credit on your state income tax. The contribution also may be an itemized deduction on your federal tax return. To be eligible for the tax credit, your check must be payable to the ECCOG Enterprise Zone, and noted on the memo line that the contribution is for the City of Burlington Economic Development Board—Parmer Park. Upon receipt of your contribution, ECCOG will return a certification form to attach to your tax return. Any state tax credit not used in the current year can be carried forward for up to five years.

### II. The Rotary Club of Burlington Charitable Foundation:

You may donate through the Rotary Club of Burlington Charitable Foundation, a tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Gifts to a 501(c)(3) organization generally entitle the donor to an itemized tax deduction. Please make your check out to: The Rotary Club of Burlington Charitable Foundation

**Note:** A charitable gift must be made before the last day of the tax year in which you wish to receive the charitable tax deduction or tax credit.
