Who: You, your friends, and your families.

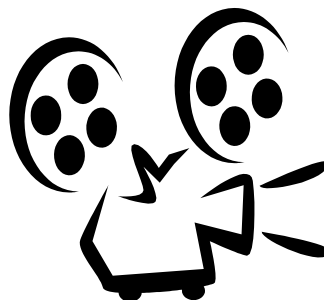

Just a few reminders about weeds, All noxious weeds are illegal in Colorado, so please help out and help eradicate them, Tall weeds can be a fire hazard and can conceal children or animals near the road. And finally, it is the property owner's responsibility to maintain weeds and landscaping in the Right of Way.

Public Notice:

You have a right to know!

The water served by the Town of Ignacio did not meet the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environmental (CDPHE) drinking water regulations due to failing to submit the two required samples for the month of March 2011 to test for Coliform Bacteria. This notice has been distributed to comply with primary drinking water requirements of CDPHE.

In the future, the Town Staff will insure the required monthly samples are collected each month. In six months of regular sampling and compliance, the Town of Ignacio will be in compliance with CDPHE.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in public places or by distributing copies by hand.

In no way does this mean the drinking water is unsafe, only that the required samples were not taken and or analyzed.

Dogs at Large

As per Ignacio Town Ordinance 115 (4-10-89) and Chapter 7, Section 2-3 the following should be kept in mind for all dog owners in Ignacio.

- (A) All dogs shall be kept under restraint and shall not be allowed to run at large.
- (C) No dog shall be allowed to cause a nuisance. The owner of every dog shall be held responsible for every behavior of such dog under the provisions of this ordinance.
- (D) Any person failing to comply with the provisions of 7-2-2 and 7-2-3 shall be cited into court and fines imposed by the judge.
