179-ORDINANCE NO. 2008-35

TOWN OF ALPINE MUNICIPAL TAX LEVY  
FISCAL YEAR 2008/2009

WHEREAS, as provided by Article 15, Section 6 of the Wyoming Constitution, municipal governments are authorized to levy a maximum of eight (8) mils on the real property and improvements located within their town boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that the maximum authorized mil levy of eight (8) mils is necessary and required to assist the Town in meeting its financial responsibilities and liabilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ALPINE:

Section 1. That there shall hereinafter be imposed a tax levy of eight (8) mils on each and every dollar of the assessed valuation of the land and real property within the town boundaries of the Town of Alpine for the 2008/2009 fiscal year.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2008.

Section 3. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 4. That any ordinances or parts or ordinances that may be in conflict herewith are repealed.

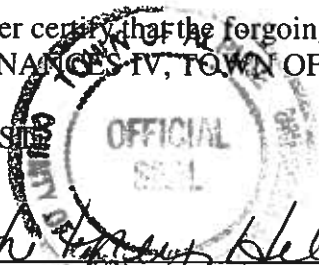
