PUBLIC/ LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Alpine Town Council will hold a public hearing on an annexation request initiated by the Town of Alpine for approximately 7.45 Acres of land commonly referred to as the Northbound lane of U.S. Highway 89 that passes through the Town of Alpine said property being located within the SE1/4 of Section 30 and the SW1/4SW1/4 of Section 29, T37N R118W, Lincoln County, Wyoming. The public hearing will be held on December 18, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard. The hearing will be held in the Alpine town Hall located at 250 River Circle. The purpose of the public hearing is for the Town Council to determine if the proposed annexation complies with Wyoming Statute § 15-1-402 regarding the purpose of the annexation in that the annexation is for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of persons residing in the Town of Alpine, whether the annexation constitutes a natural, geographical, economical and social part of the Town of Alpine, whether the annexation is a logical and feasible addition, whether the area is contiguous with or adjacent to the Town of Alpine and whether or not the Town of Alpine is prepared to issue necessary franchises to serve the annexed area. A location map which includes identifiable landmarks and boundaries of the area sought to be annexed and the areas which will, as a result of the annexation, be brought within one half mile of the new corporate limits of the Town of Alpine is included as part of this notice. The annexation report can be summarized as follows:

- The total estimated cost of infrastructure improvements required of all landowners by the Town of Alpine related to the annexation: none.
- The basic and other services customarily available to residents of the Town of Alpine and a timetable of when those services will be available: not applicable.
- The projected annual fee or service cost for those services described directly above: not applicable.
- The current and projected property tax mill levies imposed by the municipality: 8 mills.
- The cost of infrastructure improvements required within the existing boundaries of the municipality to accommodate the proposed annexation: none.
