

166- ORDINANCE NO.2008-22
EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE GOVERNING SNOW REMOVAL AND PARKING IN WINTER MONTHS.

Whereas: due to the amount of snow generally received in the Town of Alpine during the winter months, it is necessary to impose certain restrictions and rules pertaining to snow removal.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ALPINE, WYOMING IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1.

Violation of ordinance to constitute misdemeanor; penalties; impoundment of vehicle

It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance. Every person cited for a violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall:

- (i) For a first citation be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00);
- (ii) For a second citation of the same offense within one year thereafter, be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00);
- (iii) For a third or subsequent citation of the same offense within one year thereafter, be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

In addition to, and notwithstanding any of the foregoing penalties, any vehicle found parked in any unauthorized place or in violation of this chapter may be towed and impounded. The owner of such vehicle shall be required to pay all charges of towing and storage incurred thereby in addition to any other penalties imposed for violation of this chapter.

Snow Removal

No person shall park, place or leave any vehicle or trailer on any public street, alley or Town of Alpine right-of-way between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:30 a.m. during the months of November through April.

No person shall sweep, plow, push, shovel or cause snow to come to rest on or upon any public sidewalk, street, alley, property or right of way of the Town of Alpine or Lincoln County, or upon any private property without the express written consent of the owner of such property.

SECTION II.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate distinct and independent and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.

SECTION IV.

Adoption of this ordinance shall be by emergency ordinance provisions under suspension of rules and approved by not less than $\frac{3}{4}$ of the qualified members as required and set forth in Wyoming Statutes Section 15-1-115. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proclamation by the Mayor.
