

174 ORDINANCE NO. 2008-30

ADOPTING INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING 139 ORDINANCE NO. 2006-09 AND PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE 2006 EDITION FOR THE TOWN OF ALPINE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ALPINE, WYOMING IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION I.

139 Ordinance No. 2006-09 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION II.

International Fuel Gas Code - Adoption by reference.

All buildings and structures constructed, located or placed within the town from and after March 5, 2008 shall be constructed or built in accordance with the requirements of the 2006 Edition of the International Fuel Code, as promulgated by the International Code Council, and the said International Fuel Gas Code is adopted by reference the same if it were fully set forth herein, except as follows:

1. Section 101.1 **Title** shall read, "These regulations shall be known as the Fuel Gas Code of the Town of Alpine, hereinafter referred to as this code".
2. Section 106.5.2 **Fee Schedule** shall read, "The fees for work shall be indicated in the adopted Town of Alpine Mechanical/Plumbing permit schedule".
3. A third sentence shall be added to Section 107.2.3 **Re-inspection and testing** and shall read, "A re-inspection fee will be assessed for each inspection or re-inspection when such portion or the work for which inspection is requested is not complete or when required corrections have not been made. Re-inspection fees may be assessed when the approved plans are not readily available to the inspector, for failure to provide access on the date for which inspection is requested or for deviating from the plans requiring the approval of the Town of Alpine".
4. Section 108.4 **Violation Penalties** shall read, "Any person who violates a provision of this code or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements thereof or who shall erect, install, alter or repair plumbing or mechanical work in violation of the approved construction documents or directive of the code official, or of a permit or certificate of occupancy issued under the provisions of this code, shall, upon conviction, be punished as provided in 111-Ordinance No. 2005-01 of the Town of Alpine Municipal Code".
5. The last sentence of Section 108.5 **Stop work orders** shall read, "Any person who shall continue any work in or about the structure after having been served with a stop work order, except such work as that person is directed to perform to remove a violation or unsafe condition shall, upon conviction, be punished as provided in 111-Ordinance No. 2005-01 of the Town of Alpine Municipal Code".
6. Section 303.3 **Prohibited Locations** Exception number 3 and 4 shall be deleted.
7. Section 403.4.3 **Copper and Brass** shall be revised to read "Copper piping shall not be used for natural gas piping".
8. Section 603.1 **Log lighters** shall have the following sentence added "All gas fired log lighters shall be provided with a listed pilot safety device installed in accordance with the manufacturer's installation requirements".

- 9. **Unvented room heaters** Section 621.2 **Prohibited Use** shall be deleted.
- 10. Section 621.4 **Prohibited locations** shall read, “Unvented room heaters shall not be installed in habitable spaces”.
- 11. Section 621.7 **Unvented log heaters**. A first sentence shall be added that reads, “Unvented log heaters shall not be installed in habitable spaces”.

Said code shall be available in the offices of the town clerk and the town building official.

SECTION II.

Priority of ordinances.

In the event any of the adopted ordinances of the town as codified in this code as of the date of the adoption of the ordinance codified in this section conflict with any other sections of the Town of Alpine Municipal Code, the most restrictive shall apply.

SECTION III.

Severability.

If any provisions of this Ordinance or the application thereof any person or circumstances is held invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or application, and to this and the provisions of this act are severable.

SECTION IV.

Ordinances Repealed.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION V.

Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective from the date of its passage.
