A RESOLUTION COMPLYING WITH THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION'S (FTC) IDENTITY THEFT RED FLAG RULE REQUIRING UTILITIES TO DEVELOP AN IDENTITY THEFT PREVENTION PROGRAM.


WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the rule is to protect against the establishment of false accounts and ensure existing accounts are not being manipulated; and

WHEREAS, implementation of good management practices to protect personal consumer data can prevent identity theft; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body supports the idea of adopting security procedures to protect consumer information and to prevent unauthorized access;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Town of Alpine that the Utilities Department will assess their existing identity theft risk for new and existing accounts and use the risk assessment to select measures (red flags) that may be used to detect attempts to establish fraudulent accounts or manipulate existing accounts through adoption of an Identity Theft Program.
