

## **TOWN OF ALPINE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Monday, April 12, 2010 the Town of Alpine will hold a public information meeting at 7:00 p.m. at 250 River Circle, Alpine, Wyoming in the Alpine Town Hall.

The purpose of the public information meeting is to allow citizens to review and comment on the project to upgrade the Town's water supply system. The project is designed to address the major deficiencies by upgrading piping and connections to two existing wells, completing piping and installing pump equipment in a recently drilled third well, installing an emergency back-up generator for the pumps to guard against power outages and enlarging the existing control-chlorination building to accommodate the generator and related system controls.

The Town of Alpine intends to use grant funds from the WWDC and the Wyoming Drinking Water State Revolving Loan Fund administered by the Wyoming Office of State Lands and Investments. The Town will present the preliminary design of the proposed project and discuss the estimated cost of the improvements. The Town plans to borrow a maximum of an additional \$115,335 Wyoming Drinking Water State Revolving Loan to complete the project's funding package. Increased user fees will repay the loan. The average rate increase is estimated to be \$1.54/month per user account to re-pay the maximum loan amount of \$115,335, which has terms of 2.5 percent interest and 20 years. The Town previously borrowed \$115,500 from Wyoming Drinking Water State Revolving Loan in 2006. A preliminary plan of improvements can be reviewed at the office of Rendezvous Engineering; 25 South Gros Ventre Street; Jackson, Wyoming 83001.
