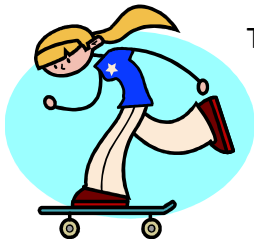

Child Development Center:

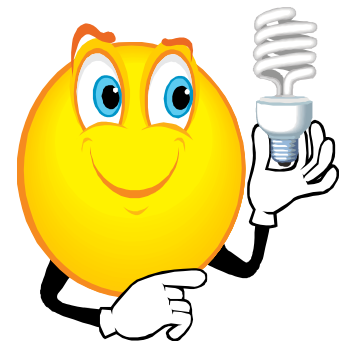

Website: The Town is in the process of upgrading the

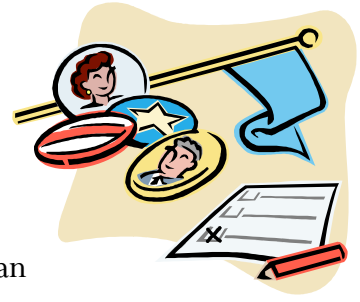

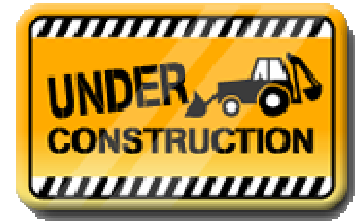

Sewer Collection System Phase 2:



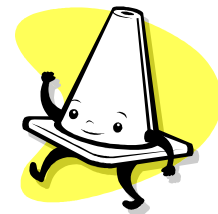
The Town has accepted Johnson Construction's bid for the Phase 2 Sewer Collection System. Work is expected to start May 1, 2010 and be completed by September of 2010. Notices have been sent out to all residences in phase 2 offering them the option for Rebates and Amortization Contracts. If you are interested please don't forget the deadline for both of these is August 31, 2010.



As for the construction of the Phase 2 Sewer System pipes will be placed within the roads of the Town until each property has a line along one adjacent side. There will also be a line placed along the north boundary connecting the lines to the sewer plant and Phase 1.



Also while the construction is going on in your area please be careful. There will be open trenches and large machinery coming and going. We also ask for your patience with the dust through out construction and unforeseen water shut offs as roads will be dug up.



Renewals: The fiscal year is coming to an end, which means Business Licenses and Pet Tags are due. Look for your reminders within the next couple of months.
