

**202 – ORDINANCE NO. 2010 – 04
TOWN OF ALPINE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010/2011**

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE TOWN OF ALPINE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010/2011 BY THE TOWN OF ALPINE JUNE 30, 2009.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF ALPINE, LINCOLN COUNTY, WYOMING THAT 202 ORDINANCE NO. 2010-04 IS THE TRUE AND CORRECT ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2010/2011.

SECTION 1: THAT THE FOLLOWING MONIES SHALL BE SET ASIDE AS ANTICIPATED FOR THE REVENUES, EXPENSES, AND OTHER DISBURSEMENTS OF THE TOWN GOVERNMENT, COMMENCING ON JULY 1, 2010, AND ENDING ON JUNE 30TH 2011.
