City of Monte Vista's Youth Sports Parents Code of Conduct

Parents and Spectators Will:

1. Remain in the spectator area during competitions. No parents allowed on the "bench" and should only talk with the players before and after the game, unless called the field of play due to an injury.
2. Let coaches coach.
3. Keep comments positive to players, parents, officials, and coaches of either team.
4. Be sober, and refrain from drinking alcohol at contests.
5. Cheer for your team.
6. Show interest, enthusiasm, and support for your child.
7. Be in control of your emotions.
8. Help when you're asked to by a coach or an official.
9. Thank the coaches, officials, and other volunteers who conducted the event.

Parent Behavior

Parents, participants, and spectators are expected to conduct themselves in a respectable, responsible, honest, and caring way. The City of Monte Vista has a no tolerance policy for behavior that is disrespectful, disruptive or rude. We will not hesitate to ask someone to leave the gym and/or facility for inappropriate behavior.

Each season all parents must sign the Code of Conduct in order for your child to participate in the program. Please be responsible for your own behavior, as well as spectators who are there to cheer on your child. Please set a good example for our kids. PARENTS AND COACHES ARE ROLE MODELS and their behavior should reflect this.

Gym Supervisors and officials have the authority to ask any spectator or coach who does not display conduct consistent with the City of Monte Vista's policies to leave the game area. This includes inappropriate comments to the officials, staff, or other participants. If a person does not leave the grounds when asked, the police may be called to facilitate their departure.
