This page is to be used as an addendum to the First Edition of the Whirly Gig Quilt Pattern dated August 2009:

Step One: Fabric Requirement Sheet (Please refer to the fabric swatches to assist you with your cutting)



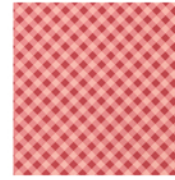
LH 03011 Rouge

Cut 6--2 1/4" h x WOF strips
Cut 1--2 3/4" h x WOF strips, then
Subcut 8--2 3/4" h x 5" rectangles
Cut 1--6" h x WOF strips, then
Subcut 4--6" squares



LH 06050 Rose

Cut 4-- 6 1/2" w x 54" LOG strips



LH 08053 Rouge

Cut 4--1 1/2" h x WOF strips



LH 06047 Rouge

Cut 2--2 3/4" h x WOF strip, then
Subcut 4--2 3/4" squares
& 8--2 3/4" h x 5" rectangles
Cut 1--5" h x WOF strip, then
Subcut 4--5" squares



LH 06033 Rouge (Backing Fabric)

Cut 7--2 3/4" h x WOF strips, then
Subcut 48--2 3/4" squares
& 24--2 3/4" h x 5" rectangles
Cut 2--6" h x WOF strips, then
Subcut 8--6" squares



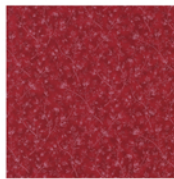
LH 07009 Powder

Cut 1--2 3/4" h x WOF strip, then
Subcut 2--2 3/4" h x 5" rectangles
Cut 1--6" h x WOF strip, then
Subcut 2--6" squares



LH 08023 Powder

Cut 1--2 3/4" h x 1/2 WOF strip,
then Subcut 2--2 3/4" h x 5" rec-
tangles
Cut 1--6" h x 1/2 WOF strip, then
Subcut 2--6" blocks



LH 06036 Claret

Cut 3--2 3/4" h x 1/2 WOF strips,
then Subcut 20--2 3/4" squares



LH 06036 Rouge

Cut 2--2 3/4" h x 1/2 WOF strips,
then Subcut 8--2 3/4" squares



LH 03035 Geranium

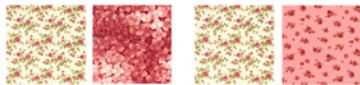
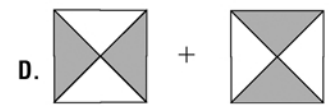
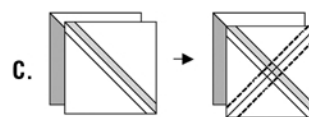
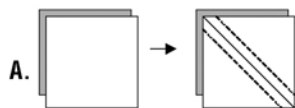
Cut 2--2 3/4" h x 1/2 WOF strips,
then Subcut 8--2 3/4" squares



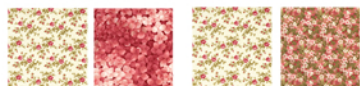
LH 08001 Rouge

Cut 9--9 1/2" squares

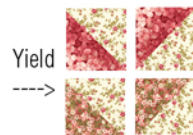
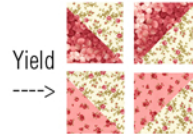
Step Two: X Blocks (Follow A thru D for both fabric combinations of "X-style" Blocks)



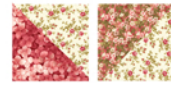
Face to Face Face to Face
Sew diagonal seams 1/4" in from marked diagonal line



Repeat with this color combination



Place two units Face to Face,
match sewn seams,
Sew 2nd set of diagonal seams



Step Five: Framed Flower Blocks (aka Snowball Blocks)

Each of these 9 focal point blocks are made from 1--9 1/2" fussy cut square & 4--2 3/4" corner squares. These smaller squares are sewn to the larger square on their diagonals. The excess fabric is trimmed on the outside corners, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Then each corner is pressed back into place. **See the Diagrams A thru C:**

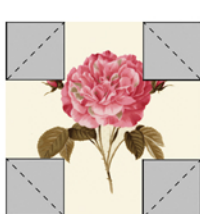


Diagram A

Pin the small squares to the 4 corners of the large fussy cut square. Mark the diagonal lines with a ruler & soft pencil. Sew on the diagonal lines.



Diagram B

Trim away excess fabric on the outside corners.



Diagram C

Gently press corners back to reveal your framed flower block.
