## Corrections

### Sleigh Ride

Supplies: Instead of  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard of black, you will need  $1\frac{1}{4}$  yard of black, plus the  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. for binding.  
Instead of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  yard for the background, you will need  $1\frac{3}{4}$  yard.

The gold referred to in the supplies and cutting is later called brown. They are one and the same.

Also, I failed to include instructions for piecing the center star! There should be four  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " red and four  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " background plaid squares remaining. Use these to make eight bias square units for the center star. These should be squared up to  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". The remaining  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " gold and background plaid squares make up the rest of the star.

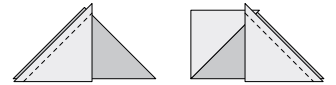
### Let It Snow

Supplies: If you don't want to piece the backing, purchase 1 yard of fabric instead of the  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard listed.  
HOWEVER, if you purchased only  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard, a backing can be pieced with the leftover portion of the border strip fabric.

### Holly Baskets

Cutting: From the cream setting fabric, you will need to cut **44** —  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

To make the sawtooth border using the method I describe on page 11 under *Finishing*, do not cut the  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cream squares in half or the  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " red squares twice diagonally. However, if you have cut these already, the size is correct and the flying geese units can be made in the traditional way as shown in the diagram here.



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
