## For The House

### **The following is an ALTERNATE CUTTING & PIECING METHOD for the OUTER BORDER**

From cream background cut:

- 28 –  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " instead of Template A trapezoids
- 6 –  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " squares instead of Template B pieces
- 4 –  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

From red cut:

- 92 –  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares instead of Template A trapezoids
- 6 –  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " squares instead of Template B pieces

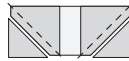
On the wrong side of 56 red  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares, mark a line along the diagonal.

Place a red square on one end of a  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " cream rectangle and sew along the drawn diagonal line. Trim off the excess  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the stitching and press the seam toward the red triangle. Repeat this on the other side. Make 28 of these units.

Make 12 half square units using the  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " squares.

Use these units and the  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " red squares to make 2 side borders and 2 end borders.

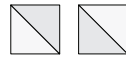
Use the remaining half square units and  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " square to make 4 corner units.



**BORDER UNIT**

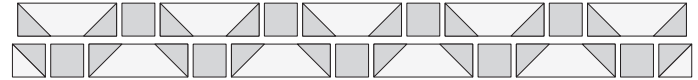


**HALF SQUARE UNIT**

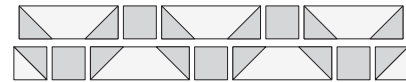
