Ouilter Basics

- Please read all instructions before beginning.
- Label your cut pieces
- All instructions use 1/4" seam allowance.
- Press all seams toward dark fabric.
- 22" measurement is approximate
- WOF is approximately 40"

Cutting

Referring to the chart, cut & label each piece with it's size and column number. (These are the fabrics used in the cover quilt, consider using different prints and textures when buying fabrics for your own quilt.)

Rouenneries were the cotton prints printed in Rouen, France during the mid-18th century. Our designs are based on a collection of old prints and stripes from that era.

From the remaining fabric, 4 light fat quarters and one Loyer Coke™cut:

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from EACH of 12–10"x 10" layer (ake™ squares cut: 1–8½"x 8½" square
from EACH of 8–10"x 10" layer (ake™ squares cut: 2–4½"x 10" rectangles (for Blocks A and B)
from EACH of 17–10"x 10" layer (ake™ squares cut: 1–6½"x 10" strip
subcut 1–6½"x 6½" square
1–6½"x 2½" rectangle
1–2½"x 10" strip
from EACH of 5–10"x 10" layer (ake™ squares cut: 4–2½"x 10" rectangles
from EACH of 4 light fat quarters cut: (#13524–16, 13525–13, 13526–14, 13528–15)
2–6½"x 22" strips
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subcut $16-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

subcut 2-2½"x 10" rectangles

from the remaining fabrics cut:

1-2½"x 22" strips


1–2½"x 10" rectangle 4–5½"x 5½" squares 6–5½"x 2½" rectangles 1–5½"x 3½" rectangle

Binding: 8–2½"x WOF strips


Construction

Blocks A and B are scrappy blocks. Do not worry about the placement of lights and darks - just sew!

1 (A) Join 2–2½"x 10" and 1–4½"x 10" rectangles together. *See diagram*. Press away from the center strip. Make 8 strip sets. Cut 15–4½" wide units. (B) Join 2–2½"x 10" and 1–4½"x 10" rectangles together. *See diagram*. Press towards the center strip. Make 8 strip sets. Cut 30–2½" wide units. (C) Join 2–2½" wide units and 1–4½" wide unit. *See diagram*. Make 15 of Block A.



Combine 3–6½"x 2½" rectangles. Press in one direction. Repeat to make 26 of Block B.



Assemble Quilt_

Referring to the diagram on the center page, sew the column pieces together, noting the location of the labeled fabric pieces. There is no right or wrong placement for the rest of the blocks, except for size and block type (A or B), let your eye decide which block to use next. Press. Join completed columns.

Finishing_

4 Join the 8–2½"xWOF Binding strips. Layer, quilt and bind the quilt.

Fabric Requirements:

Quilt Top:

- 1 Layer CakeTM (42-10"x10"squares)
- 2 woven fat quarters
- 9 assorted prints 1/4 yard of EACH
- 3 prints ¹/₃ yard of EACH
- 4 light fat quarters

Binding: 3/4 yard

Backing: 5 yards



Please note, kit yardage may vary slightly from amounts given on this project sheet.
