Development Fees

The Development fee structure has two parts.

- The first part is a 'non-refundable fee' to cover Town expenses, such as publication costs, recording fees, staff time for personnel who are not heavily involved in the project, and do not keep a detailed task and client code time sheet.
- The second part of the fee structure is a 'refundable deposit', based on an estimate for the type of project, to cover charges by the Town's consultants or staff including: Planners, Landscape

Architects, Engineers, Surveyors, and Attorneys. Once 85% of the deposit has been expended, the applicant will be notified of an estimated additional deposit required.
