### Message from Mayor - Veteran's Memorial

As I have mentioned before, there are a number of things happening in Milliken - good things, things to be celebrated. The Kids & Cops Park is in full swing; the old Town Hall/Police Station is being renovated and vendors for the coffee house are showing much interest.

Now I want to remind you of another event in which you can participate, physically, emotionally perhaps, and financially.

At the west side of the new Police Station/Meeting House, just north of the steps are three flag poles. This entire area will be a Veteran's Memorial reminding us of the sacrifice made by men and women in defense of our country. A plaque, with the names of Milliken residents who died in WWII and Korea will become a permanent addition to the wall, behind the flag poles, joining the plaque that is already there that shows the name of the first Milliken resident to die in war.

So, how can you participate in this memorial? First of all, please come to the Veteran's Memorial on Memorial Day, Monday, May 30th at 10:00am. Freedom has its cost and honoring those who pay that debt is of utmost importance.

Second, the wall behind the flags will eventually be covered with blocks, different sized blocks, that will have engraved names of residents and former residents who have served in the different military services. I, personally, bought a block for my husband who spent a total of 38 years in two different services, the Army and the Air Force. I felt this was a wonderful way to remember his service. A 6"x 6" block costs \$90.00; a 6"x 12" block costs \$160.00; a 12"x 12" block costs \$300.00. There are applications available at Town Hall. While I know this is definitely a financial commitment, please remember those blocks will remain on that wall as positive reminders to all who see them about what it takes to have the freedom we all enjoy.

So, consider purchasing a block for the Veteran's Memorial to honor a member of your family or someone who deserves recognition on that wall. Also, don't forget to mark Monday, May 30th on your calendar so you can attend the Memorial Day event.
