

ORDINANCE 621

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MILLIKEN MUNICIPAL CODE REGULATING THE PARKING OF TRAILERS, AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY OF THE TOWN OF MILLIKEN, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, it has been observed that trailers, motorhomes, and recreational vehicles are being parked on public property, alleys and public right-of-ways for extended periods of time,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MILLIKEN, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1: Paragraph (d) of Section 8-2-30 of the Town of Milliken Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

1. The owner or operator of any motor home, recreational vehicle, or trailer of any sort, other than a authorized emergency vehicle, shall not park said vehicle or trailer on a public roadway, alley or right-of-way, designated for parking, for longer than seventy-two (72) hours total within a period of seven consecutive days. Moving the vehicle or trailer a short distance and re-parking it does not restart the allowable seventy-two hour period.

Section 2: Effective Date:

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Milliken herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

At its meeting January 27, 2010, this Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees.
