Watering Rules

Town residents may begin watering their lawns with automatic sprinkler systems on March 1st.

Residents may water three days per week under the following schedule:

- **Addresses ending in an even number, 0,2,4,6,8 may water on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 12:01am to 9:00am and 7:00pm to 12midnight.**
- **Addresses ending in an odd number, 1,3,5,7,9 may water on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, 12:01am to 9:00am and 7:00pm to 12midnight.**
- **Automatic sprinklers are NOT permitted on Sunday.**

Residents may also use water to clean hard surfaces such as driveways, patios, house siding, windows, etc. as long as you are using a positive shut off device attached to your hose, such as an on/off sprayer/nozzle.

Residents may also obtain Seed/Sod Planting Exemption Permits at any time. Permits can be obtained at Town Hall.

Those residents with private wells are exempt from the rules, but are strongly encouraged to reduce consumption and follow the guidelines if possible. You must place a sign on the residence indicating the use of a well.



A garden hose can pour out 600 gallons or more in only a few hours. Use a shut-off nozzle on your hose that can be adjusted down to a fine spray, so that water flows only as needed.

CLEAN-UP DAY & e-CYCLE - SATURDAY, MAY 12, 2012

The Town of Milliken will conduct Spring Clean-Up Day on Saturday, May 12, 2012 from 8:00am to 2:00pm at the Public Works Facility located at 2951 Ash Street, east of Town on HWY 60 (first left hand turn lane) to Road 23½. Turn left (north) to the drop site. Clean-Up Day provides the residents of the community an opportunity to dispose of items from their home and property at no cost. Metal recycling and household hazardous waste drop-off will also be available. *All items not specified on the list will be accepted by Waste Management for a piece charge between \$3 - \$25 depending on the item size. Price will be negotiated between Waste Management Representative and participant.*
