Civil War Journals Block of the Month: Inspired by the Civil War Journals collection by Judie Rothermel for Marcus Brothers Fabrics. Quilts are designed by Homestead Hearth. You can either make a larger quilt that finishes at 84" x 102" or four smaller quilts that are approximately 45" x 52" each. The Civil War Journals BOM focuses on the children of the 1860s. 12 month program. \$39.95 for 9 months, months 10-12 are free provided first 9 months are paid for.

Raining Cats & Dogs Block of the Month: If you love cats and dogs, this is the quilt for you. It is a 10 month program beginning in February. The pattern and embellishments are from Bunny Hill Design and the fabric is from Moda. Quilt finishes 55" x 62" 10 month program \$27.50/month

Table Runner of the Month: Who doesn't love putting a table runner on their table for a special occasion or to fit the season? Each month you will receive a kit which includes instructions for the runner, fabric for the top, backing and binding. All you need to complete the runner is thread, batting and the desire to finish the runner. Program begins January 1st.

\$24.95/month. Or pay \$250.00 by February 29th for the whole year. (It's like getting 2 months free.)

Strips of the Month Quilt: Strip by strip quilt using Seminole Pattern rows begins in March. Additional information to follow.

## CURVE CHALLENGE

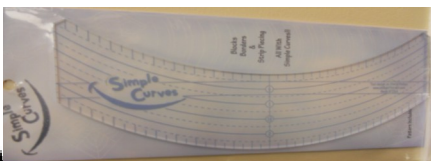
Here at Olde City Quilts we are going to throw you a "Curve" challenge.

## Building Blocks with Judy

The classes and workshops below were developed mainly with the beginner quilter in mind, however all are welcome!!

**Hook, Line & Sinker - Beginners Beware!** These sessions are meant to lure you into the wonderful world of quilting without sinking your wallet. Test the waters with Judy! You will complete three projects during this three hour class. No experience needed!! We provide the machine, cutting tools, and accessories. \$40 includes all supplies. 1/12 5p-8p, 1/22 12n-3p, 2/25 2p-5p, 3/24 1p-4p

**Learn to Quilt - OCQ'S Signature Class**, specializing in beginners. Judy takes students on a 10 week trip. Your trail begins with fabric and ends with quilting and binding, completing a nine block sampler quilt while learning many techniques. Class members receive special discounts on things needed along the way. \$120 + supplies. Current Saturday Morning sessions (9a-11a) end 2/18 Tuesday Evening Class starts 2/7 6p-8p

**Fabric Selection Workshop** - This has to be my favorite part of quilting ..selecting the fabric! I do understand that not all of you share my enthusiasm. We will briefly review color theory, but concentrate on tips of fabric selection and how to become more comfortable with figuring out how much fabric you need for specific needs. **Cutting Workshop** - Cutting your fabric accurately is one of the most important aspects to an even block. We will review the "do's & don'ts" of cutting. **Binding Workshop** - The first part of the workshop will be a demonstration on the different methods of binding to include machine binding and bias binding. ## LONG ARM CLASSES/RENTAL

Hand Guided Basics: If you are interested in quilting your own quilts, this is the place to begin. Sign up to take a 2 hour lesson, where you will learn to use one of the hand guided Gammill machines. Lesson will include hands on instructions to load and quilt your practice piece using free motion as well as pantograph designs. Fee of \$60 includes lesson & practice piece.

Statler Basics: Once you have taken the Hand Guided Basics class you may take this class. Here you will learn how to operate the Computerized Statler Gammill Machines. Lesson will include hands on instructions on how to set up and do basic edge to edge quilting. Fee of \$60 includes lesson & group practice piece. You may also purchase an optional instruction booklet for \$10

Blocks & Boundries: Step into the world of custom quilting. Place patterns into defined areas of the quilt and manipulate their size and shape to enhance your piecing. Topics include identifying block designs, drawing boundaries, echo quilting, rotating patterns, rubber stamp, circular arrays, and much more. 1/18 or 2/15 6p-8p. Fee \$30.

Borders & Corners: Learn to place designs into sashing and borders. You must complete Blocks and Boundaries prior to taking this class. Learn to identify Point to Point (P2P) designs and both border and corner designs. Several modes of operation are learned; P2P, Repeat Pattern, Borders & Corners, and the measure tool. 1/27 10a-12p. Fee \$30.

Advanced Edge to Edge & E2E Recovery: Learn to alternate patterns within an E2E Project to produce more interesting and well nested designs. Learn to recover an E2E Project when the unthinkable happens! User Error! 1/4 2p-4p or 1/16 1p-3p
