THE ROMAN CROSS

10.5" X 10.5" (finished)

All instructions are written for rotary cutting.



(Refer to diagram for placement)

- A. (Tips of cross)

 Cut two squares 2-1/4". Sub cut each diagonally to make 4 diamonds.
- B. Background fabric cut 3 squares 3-7/8" Sub cut diagonally both directions producing 12 diamonds.
- C. Striped rectangles Cut one strip 25". Sub cut 4 rectangles 6-1/8" X 2-3/8".
- D. Background Cut 4 squares 2-3/8" X 2-3/8" Cross Cut 8 squares 2-3/8" X 2-3/8" Accent square Cut 1 square 2-3/8" X 2-3/8"

Sewing the block:

- 1. Sew together the center 9-patch squares. Press.
- 2. Sew each triangle A to square D.
- 3. Sew one background triangle B to each side of pieced section you just made. Press.
- 4. Sew two of these corner sections to rectangle C. Press
- 5. Sew one section to each side of 9-patch unit sewn previously. Press.
- 6 Sew one background triangle to each side of remaining rectangles. Press
- 7. Sew remaining pieced corners to one side of rectangle unit.
- 8. Sew these pieced corner units to each side of central section to complete your block.

Press well and trim to 10.5" square.
