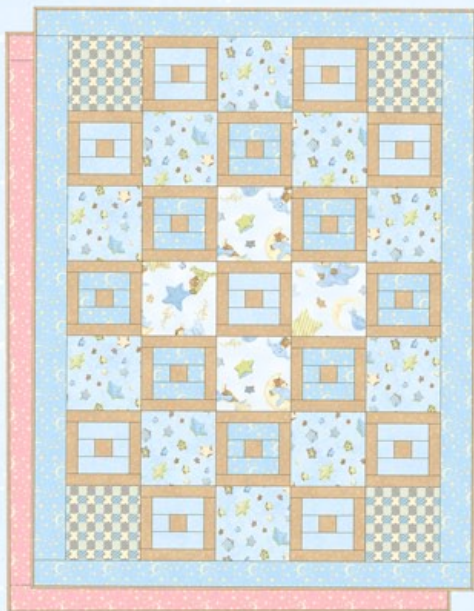

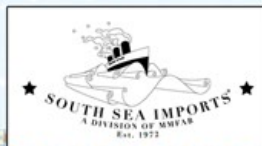

Swingin' On A Star

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated. This is a reversible quilt, so piece the front and back separately, then layer all together.

1. Cut the following for the FRONT:

Fabric A or **Fabric B** - cut 1 - 30 1/2" x 41 1/2" (center design evenly)

Fabric F - cut 3 - 4 1/2" strips, subcut 12 - 4 1/2" x 8" and 2 - 4 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles

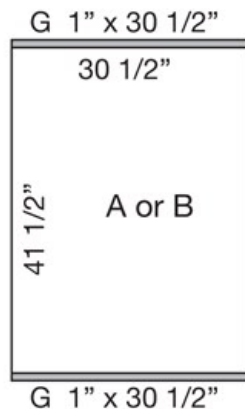
Fabric G - cut 2 - 2 1/2" strips (4-Patches)
cut 2 - 1" x 30 1/2"

BINDING - cut 5 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

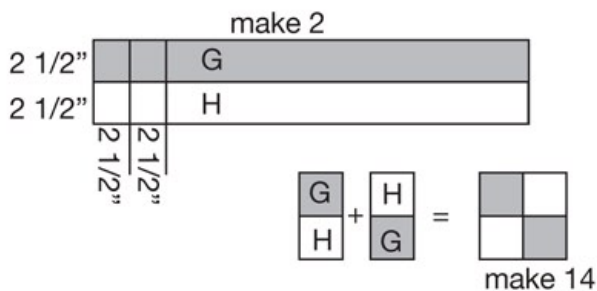
Fabric H - cut 2 - 2 1/2" strips (4-Patches)

2. FRONT Piecing Order:

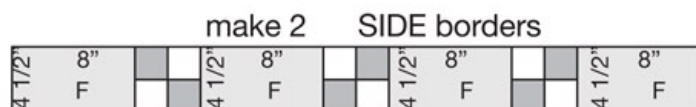
1. Sew **G** 1" x 30 1/2" strip to the top and bottom of center square **A** or **B**.



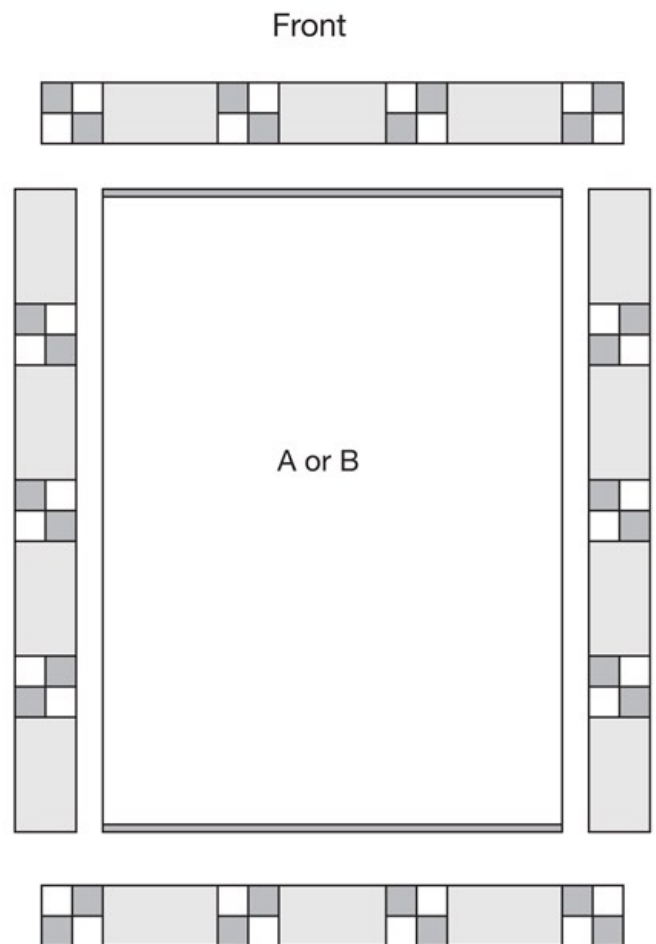
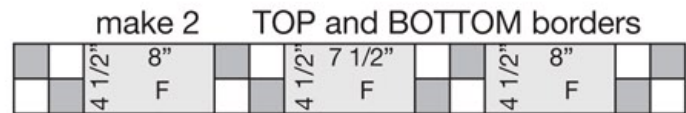
2. Make 14 - 4" finished (4 1/2" unf.) 4-Patches. Sew two strip sets of **G** and **H** 2 1/2" strips. Press toward **G**. Subcut 28 - 2 1/2" segments. Sew segments together according to the diagram for (14) 4-Patches.



3. Sew 4-Patches alternating with **F** 4 1/2" x 8" rectangles together for the **SIDE** borders according to the diagram. Sew borders to the sides of the quilt center. **



4. Sew 4-Patches alternating with **F** 4 1/2" x 8" and 4 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles for the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram. Sew borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. **If necessary, slight adjustments may be made in **F** rectangles to allow borders to fit quilt center. The **FRONT** measures 38 1/2" x 50 1/2" unfinished.

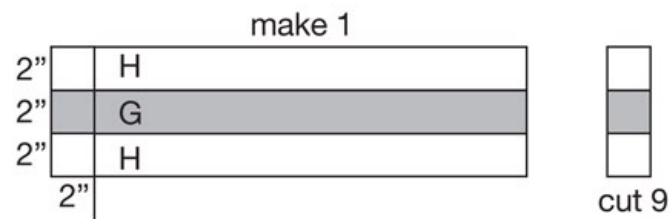


3. **Cut the following for the BACK:**

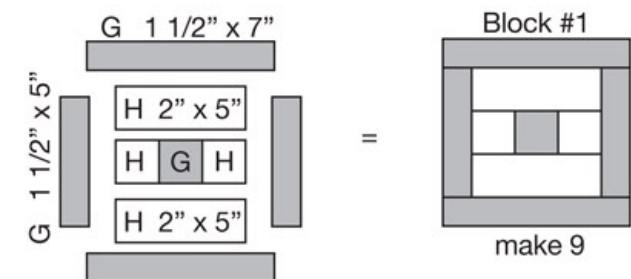
- Fabric C** - cut 1 - 7" strip, subcut 4 - 7" squares
Fabric D - cut 1 - 7" strip, subcut 4 - 7" squares
Fabric E - cut 2 - 7" strips, subcut 10 - 7" squares
Fabric F - cut 4 - 2" strips. Use 3 strips and subcut 16 - 2" x 5". Fold and cut one strip in half for 2 - 2" x 20" strips.
 Borders - cut 3 - 3 1/4" strips, sew end to end and subcut 2 - 3 1/4" x 46" (SIDES)
 cut 2 - 2 3/4" x 38 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)
Fabric G - cut 1 - 2" strip, fold and cut in half for 2 - 2" x 20" strips.
 cut 12 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 34 - 1 1/2" x 5" and 34 - 1 1/2" x 7"
Fabric H - cut 1 - 2" strip, fold and cut in half for 2 - 2" x 20" strips
 cut 3 - 2" strips, subcut 18 - 2" x 5"

4. **BACK Piecing Order:**

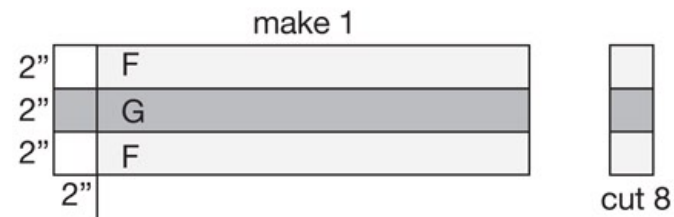
1. Make 9 - 6 1/2" finished (7" unf.) Block #1. Make 1 short strip set by sewing **H/G/H** 2" x 20" strips side by side. Press toward **G**. Subcut 9 - 2" segments.



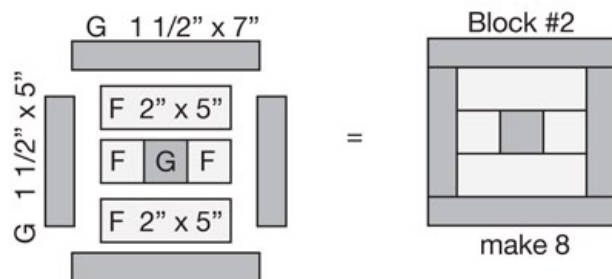
Next, sew **H** 2" x 5" rectangles above and below cut segments. Then sew **G** 1 1/2" borders around each block, sides first, then top and bottom borders according to the diagram.



2. Make 8 - 6 1/2" finished (7" unf.) Block #2. Make 1 short strip set by sewing **F/G/F** 2" x 20" strips side by side. Press toward **G**. Subcut 8 - 2" segments.

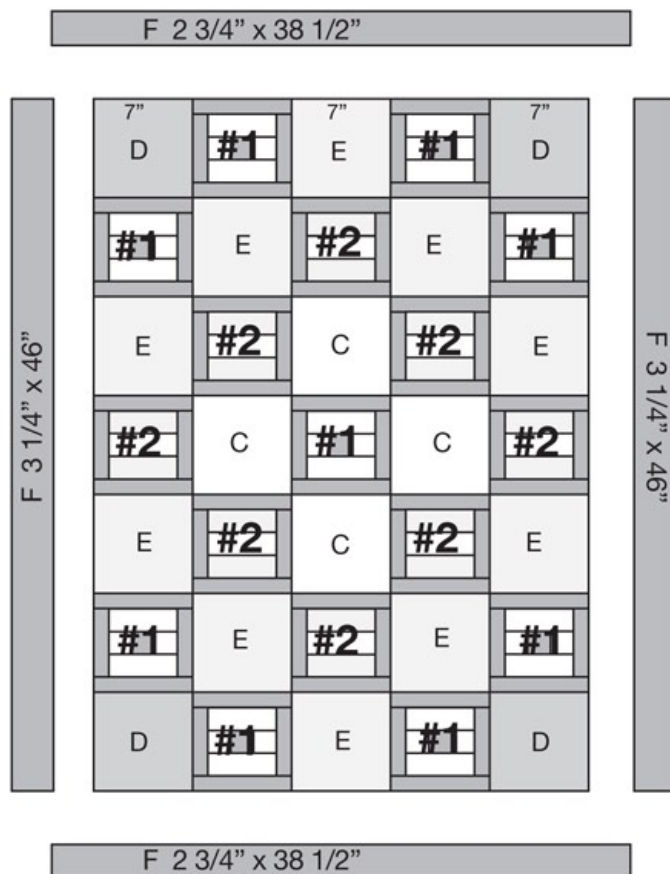


Next, sew **F** 2" x 5" rectangles above and below cut segments. Then sew **G** 1 1/2" borders around each block, sides first, then top and bottom borders according to the diagram.



3. Sew quilt back together by rows alternating blocks according to the diagram. Press away from Blocks #1 and #2.

4. Sew **F** 3 1/4" x 46" borders to both SIDES, then sew **F** 2 3/4" x 38 1/2" borders to the TOP and BOTTOM. The BACK measures 38 1/2" x 50 1/2".



5. Layer BACK, batting, and FRONT, matching raw edges. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!
