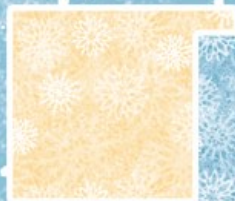

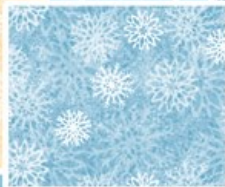

# Cool Characters

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - \*\*cut 4 - 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" and 1 - 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" (center designs evenly)

**Fabric B** - cut lengthwise 1 - 7 1/2" x 35 1/2" and 1 - 2 1/2" x 35 1/2"

**Fabric C** - cut 4 - 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" squares by centering designs evenly

**Fabric E** - \*\*cut 6 - 1" strips, subcut 8 - 1" x 10 1/2" and 8 - 1" x 11 1/2"

**Fabric F** - cut 6 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 10 - 2 1/2" x 7 1/2" and 10 - 2 1/2" x 11 1/2"

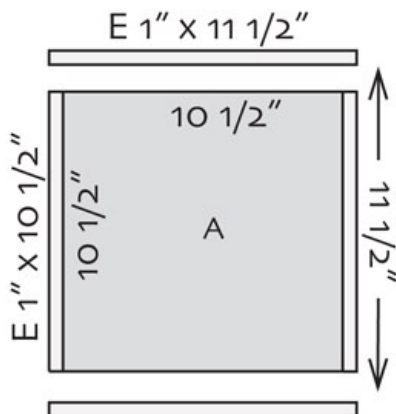
**Fabric G** - cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 6 - 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" cut 9 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 4 - 2 1/2" x 35 1/2", 2 - 2 1/2" x 50 1/2" (from 3 strips sewn end to end) and 2 - 2 1/2" x 39 1/2"

**BINDING** - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

## 2. Piecing Order:

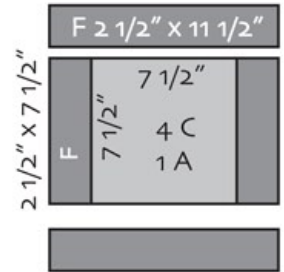
1. Sew **E** 1" borders around 4 **A** 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" squares, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.

\*\* (If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **E** borders slightly larger, sew around **A** squares, then trim all blocks to measure 11 1/2" x 11 1/2" .)



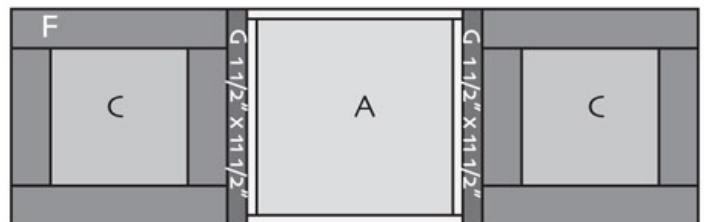

2. Sew **F** 2 1/2" borders around 4 **C** and 1 **A** 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" squares, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram.

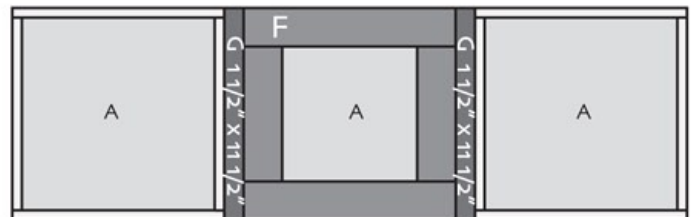

3. Make two rows of blocks alternating two **C** blocks, one **A** block and two **G** 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" sashing strips for the first and third rows of blocks. Make the center row of blocks by sewing two **A** blocks, one **A** block bordered by **F** and two **G** 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" according to the diagram.

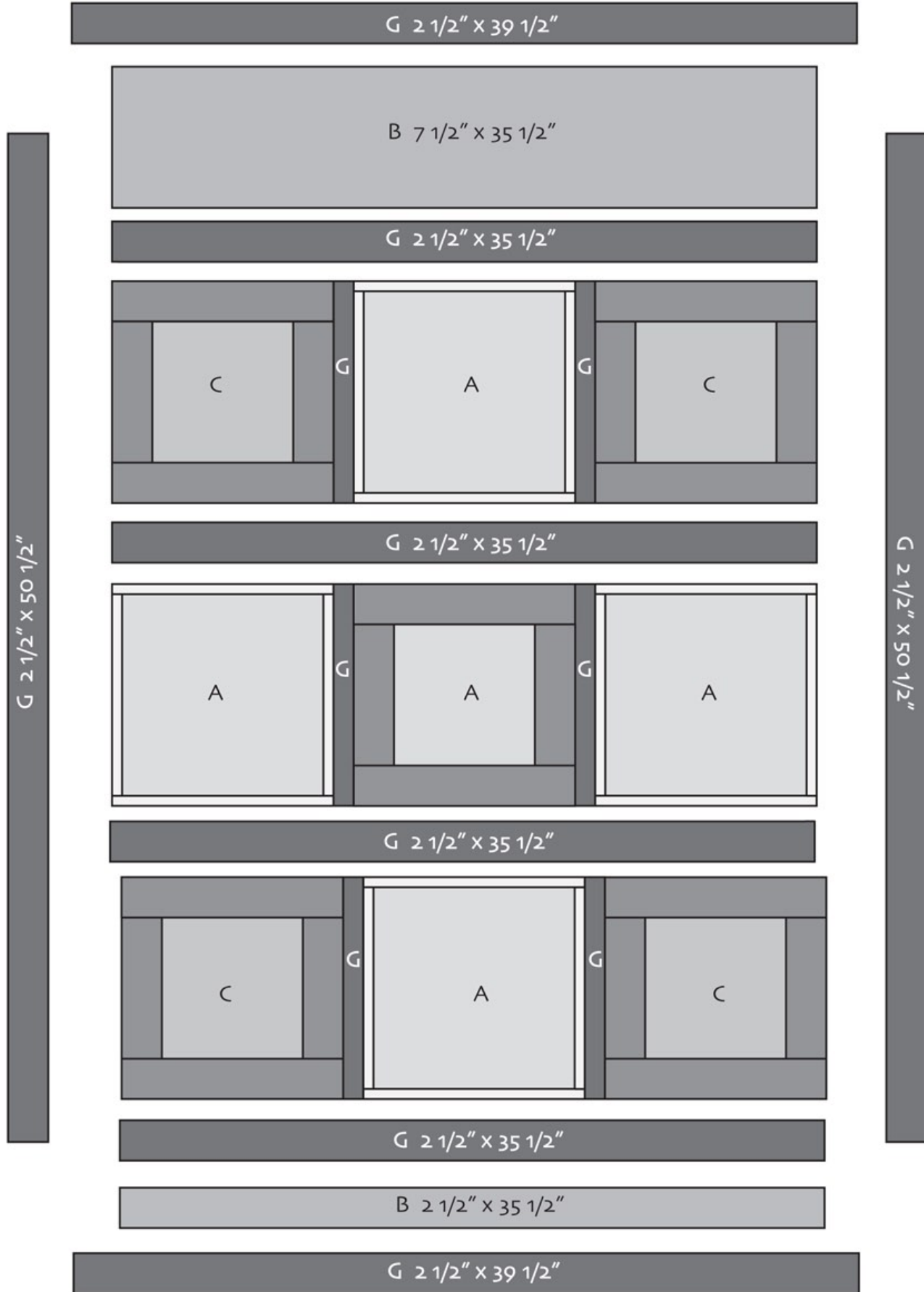


make 1 row

4. Next, connect rows of blocks by alternating four **G** 2 1/2" x 35 1/2" strips according to the diagram on the next page.

5. Sew **B** 7 1/2" x 35 1/2" to the top and sew **B** 2 1/2" x 35 1/2" to the bottom of the quilt according to the diagram.

6. Last, sew **G** 2 1/2" x 50 1/2" to the SIDES of the quilt and sew **G** 2 1/2" x 39 1/2" to the TOP and BOTTOM.



7. The quilt measures approximately  $39\frac{1}{2}'' \times 54\frac{1}{2}''$ . Make backing (**Fabric D**) at least 6" larger than the top. Layer and baste top, batting and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!
