Changes at Bentwood 2010

Expect to see change at Bentwood Golf Course in 2010. The biggest change will be the opening of the back nine tentatively scheduled for Memorial Weekend if the winter weather is agreeable with the new grass on the back nine. Concrete cart paths will be installed around the greens and tees on the back nine and a back nine restroom will be built before the opening.

Beginning April 1st all cereal malt beverages (beer) consumed at Bentwood will need to be purchased through the clubhouse. Outside beer will not be permitted on the golf course. We look forward to your cooperation with this new City policy.

A range ball dispenser will be in place at the driving range in early 2010 - tokens will be required and must be purchased at the clubhouse. All existing range rules will be in effect. Golfers with range memberships including all high school golf team members are reminded that sharing range balls is not permitted.

Membership fees will go up \$25 in 2010 for both Family and Single memberships. Green fees will increase once the back nine opens. A new nine hole green fee will be available at \$10 on weekdays and \$12 on weekends. The 18-hole green fee will become \$15 on weekdays and \$20 on weekends.

The biggest complaints we hear from golfers are slow play and poor etiquette concerning care of the golf course. If you are holding up play or not replacing divots or driving or parking your cart where it should not be, expect to be politely reminded by one of the clubhouse staff as they begin to make trips around the golf course in the coming year. These reminders are meant to help everyone to take pride in taking care of the golf course and respecting your fellow golfer.

Definitions

Membership period:

April 1st - March 31st.

Single Membership:

An individual may play throughout the year with no green fees. Members under 12 years of age may play at any time with an adult or they may play without adult supervision in accordance with all rules of a Junior Membership. (\$270.00)

Family Membership:

Any member of the family may play throughout the year with no green fees. Family members under 12 years of age may play at any time with an adult or they may play without adult supervision in accordance with all rules of a Junior Membership. Family is defined as the persons in one household - consisting of parents and children up to 18 years old or full time dependent college students up to 25 years old. (\$340.00)

Junior Membership:

Players between 9 and 17 years of age. Play is limited to weekdays between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. (No weekends or holidays). Players must be enrolled in or have completed the Grant County Recreation Junior Golf Program or be able to demonstrate a knowledge of golf rules and etiquette. (\$27.00)

Youth Membership:

Must be a full time dependent student up to 25 years old. Membership is valid as long as the person remains a full time student and up to 3 months following their last day of class. Youth members under 12 years of age may play at any time with an adult or they may play without adult supervision in accordance with all rules of a Junior Membership. (\$70.00)

High School Membership:

Team members may practice or play throughout the year as a regular member. (\$660.00)

Advanced purchase:

Available for purchase in addition to an annual membership. The member need not be present for guests to play. See the starter for purchase. (\$100.00).

There will be no refunds or reimbursements for a partial year of play and no prorating for partial year memberships. Green fees must be paid if annual membership fee is not paid in full by April 1st. A monthly payment plan that allows up to six monthly payments is available by automatic withdrawal from a bank account. Inquire at City Hall for more information on the payment plan.
