



Meet Gary Krenik. Gary was diagnosed with stage 4 terminal large cell lung cancer the first part of August 2011. The cancer had developed in his liver as well as in some bones; it is a very fast growing aggressive cancer. He had 3 cycles of chemotherapy and was doing quite well; the cancer had either disappeared or greatly reduced. He then had 2 more cycles of the chemo and started having pains in his legs and back. The doctors discontinued the chemo as they discovered that Gary had large carcinomas in his spine also. Gary then had 10 days in a row of radiation on the lumbar region of his spine to help with the pain and his walking. After the radiation the doctors then discovered that Gary's legs and lungs have extensive blood clots as well. He is being treated for these now, trying to get back some of his strength and help with breathing. We are hoping that he will be able to go back on chemotherapy in February if he gets his strength back. Gary is trusting in God to see him through this time.
