

## PILLOWCASE PATTERN

### For standard/queen pillowcase

¾ yd for body of pillowcase (Fabric A)  
 (1¼ yd if directional print)  
 ⅛ yd for accent piping (Accent Fabric)\*  
 ¼ yd for border (Border Fabric)  
 \*enough for two pillowcases

### For king pillowcase

1 yd fabric for body of pillowcase (Fabric A)  
 (1¼ yd if directional print)  
 ⅛ yd fabric for accent piping (Accent Fabric)\*  
 ¼ yd fabric for border (Border Fabric)  
 \*enough for two pillowcases

### Cutting:

Fabric A (see Note box if Fabric A is a directional print):

for standard/queen: cut rectangle 26½" x 42" →→

for king: cut rectangle 35½" x 42" →→

Accent Fabric: cut strip 2" x 42"

Border Fabric: cut strip 8½" x 42"

**Note:** If using a directional print, cut the 42" edge of the Fabric A rectangle along the selvage edge.

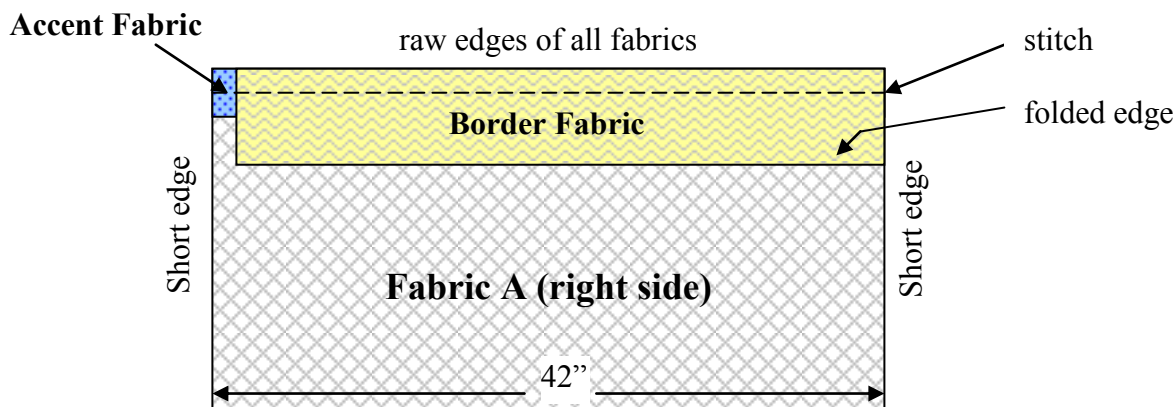
### Assembly:

**ALL SEAM ALLOWANCES ARE ½"**

With wrong sides together, press Accent Fabric in half lengthwise to form a strip 1" wide.

With wrong sides together, press Border Fabric in half lengthwise to form a strip 4¼" wide.

Layer the three fabrics in this order: Fabric A (right side up) on bottom; then the accent fabric, then the Border Fabric on top. Aligning raw edges of all three fabrics, stitch where shown in diagram. Overcast seam, if desired, to prevent fraying.



Press seam allowance towards Fabric A. Topstitch on Fabric A to hold seam allowance in place.

Fold the pillowcase so that the two short edges are aligned, right sides together.

With right sides together, stitch along the end and side of the pillowcase. Overcast seam, if desired, to prevent fraying.

Turn right side out and press.
