UPDATES:

JANUARY 2012: Uintah strives to keep city ordinances consistent with county and state law. Ordinances will be modified to meet local needs. Currently, we are working with Sterling Codifiers to codify all our ordinances. To "codify" means to arrange and systematize. Codification is the collection and organization of all ordinances of a general and permanent nature into a numbered and stylized document that is easy-to-read and easy-to-access. Codifying can also include review and revision of your ordinances to correct conflicts and inconsistencies. It is the City's goal to maintain its laws in a comprehensive, up-to-date, and understandable form in a location that citizens can find and use. During the process of codifying our ordinances, it will be necessary to revise those that need to be brought up-to-date, add those that are needed, and delete those that are not needed. During this next year, there will be a flurry of activity with our ordinances.
