

## **ANIMAL CONTROL**

### **GOALS:**

1. Provide quality customer service in all phases of animal control operations.
2. Provide services which aid in containing free-roaming animals to prevent human injuries.
3. Provide services which help prevent animals from becoming nuisances to the community or a burden to its citizens.
4. Provide a physical facility which will house lost unwanted and neglected animals in a humane manner.
5. Provide unwanted, sick or injured animals with humane euthanasia, according them dignity and respect during that act.
6. Create public information and education programs, which will assist the members of this community in becoming more responsible pet owners.

### **UPDATES:**

**FEBRUARY 2012:** We are online with Weber County for our dog licenses. Weber County will be at the City Office March 5th and April 2nd from 9 to noon and 1 to 3:30 pm for the convenience to our citizens to license their dogs.

**RABIES CLINICS** - March 17 and April 14 at 2 to 4 pm. Cost of rabies shots will be \$14. The Rabies Clinics will be held at the Weber County Animal Shelter, located at the fairgrounds.

### **All licenses in Uintah expire on April 30, 2012.**

Fees will be as follow:

- Non-sterilized \$25.00 per dog
- Sterilized \$10.00 per dog
- Sterilized owned by Senior Citizen (65 older) \$5.00 per dog
- Non-sterilized owned by Senior Citizen (65 older) \$25.00 per dog
- Mandatory Late Fee (due 30 days after license expires) \$20.00 per household
- Licensing is due 1 year from previous licensing date. For instance if you license, March 13, 2009, your license expires March 13, 2010, and the late fee applies April 30, 2012.
