UPDATES:

FEBRUARY 2012: There will be a City Council work meeting on February 28th to discuss the status of the fire department. Because a decision has not been made on the status of the fire department, at the recent City Council meeting the Request for Proposal for a new fire station was put on hold. After the meeting with the fire personnel, the city will be reviewing their input as well as all other options in order to make a decision that will be best for the City. We owe it to the community to explore all options and find out the best possible solution for our city. There will be a work meeting where the input from the fire personnel as well as the options will be discussed, and then at a following meeting a decision will be voted upon.
