GOALS:

Attend meetings relating to current and future road projects with the following goals:
Become more acquainted with officials that are responsible for transportation planning, approving, and funding.

UPDATES:

JANUARY 2012: After more dialog with UDOT officials, UDOT has decided that 6550 South will not become a one-way. An island will be constructed to allow right turn in and right turn out only for 6550 South on the west side of HWY 89. From the east, 6550 South will have no turn restrictions. Obtaining the necessary ground for the right-of-way is in the final stages. UDOT will be advertising the project as soon as the acquisitions are completed for the project. The advertising and contractor selection usually takes about month and half. Construction should then begin immediately after the contractor has been selected by UDOT.

FEBRUARY 2012: Right of way acquisition is finalized. The engineers are in the final phase for the project. Advertising for a contractor is close. Construction should begin immediately after contractor selection. The goal is to have everything done by the beginning of school in the fall.
