

OLD TOWN PARK

GOALS:

1. Operate and maintain the park in a safe and clean manner that protects the natural resources of the park and the welfare of the park patrons.
 - a. Repair fence which damaged during the high winds.
 - b. Review issues at the Old Town Park tennis court and provide solutions for alternatives to be implemented.
 - c. Identify trees that need maintenance and where new trees are needed within the city park.
2. Check all playground equipment to ensure that it is safe and up to required standards.
 - a. Replace grass, with approved sand or bark, around the play equipment at the City Hall Park.
 - b. Upgrade and provide a more efficient use for the tennis that could include both tennis and pickle-ball.
 - c. Replace high maintenance items with more sustainable, low maintenance items.
3. Look for opportunities for create new parks.
 - a. Develop the River Park.

UPDATES:

JANUARY 2012: During the recent windstorm, portions of the fence at the Old Town Park were damaged. The City has received bids to have the repairs taken care of.

FEBRUARY 2012: As we transition closer into our Spring season (hopefully sooner than later) we have various projects that will commence with our parks. Top priority will be replacing the grass, with approved sand or bark, around the play equipment at the City Hall Park. We have also completed the project of repairing/replacing the fence along the east side of the old City Park that was blown over and destroyed by the heavy winds we experienced last December.
