

RFP'S - FIRE STATION AND SECONDARY WATER

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GOALS:

1. Apply for grants that specifically support the City's goals with respect to providing decent, affordable housing, expanding economic opportunity, bettering the community, and serving low and moderate-income populations.
2. Make the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) the bases for requesting grants.
 - a. Prioritize the needs verses resources.
 - b. Use the CIP to set the goals, strategies, and priorities to apply for grants.
 - c. Involve the citizens through public hearings.
3. Acquired grants processed in timely manner according to the regulations and laws established by the entity providing the grant.
 - a. Issue Requests for Proposals for the Fire Station and Pressurized Secondary Water System.
 - b. Follow through with accounting of Fire Station and Pressurized Secondary Water System design studies.
 - c. Use selection process to identify engineering firms to do the work.
 - d. Prepare the CDBG request for funds to finance fire station construction.
 - e. Explore availability of funds for construction of secondary water system from various sources.

UPDATES:

JANUARY 2012: We have completed a draft proposal for the Request for Proposal (RFP) for a possible new fire station. We will discuss the RFP at the City Council Work Session on January 17th. **Afterwards we will make the RFP available to city residents for their review and comments. COMMENTS ARE DUE BY FEBRUARY 6th.** We expect to publish the RFP after the February 7th City Council Meeting. At our work session, we will also discuss the progress made in preparation for an RFP for a possible pressurized secondary water system.

FEBRUARY 2012: At the last City Council, both Request for Proposal (RFP) were approved. However, the one for the fire station was put on hold as discussed under the fire station section. The RFP for the secondary water was given to our city engineer to complete.
