The striking coordinated backing makes this runner reversible!





<p>Windham Fabrics American Heritage 27834-2</p> 	<p>Use the 1—14" x 54" strip included in your kit to layer your runner. Quilt and then trim as needed.</p>																							



Please read all instructions before piecing and assembling the quilt.

















1. Half Square Triangle Unit (18 total)

<p>Step 1. Using a pencil or quilting marker, draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner on the wrong side of the 9—5" x 5" Red colored squares of fabric.</p>	
<p>Step 2. Pair up the 5" x 5" Red squares with the 5" x 5" Cream squares of fabric. Place with right sides together, edges matching and the cream fabric face up.</p>	
<p>Step 3. Stitch a <i>scant</i> 1/4" seam on BOTH SIDES of the drawn line. If you do not have a 1/4" foot you will need to draw in these sewing lines as well as the diagonal cutting line.</p>	
<p>Step 4. Use scissors or a rotary cutter to cut the squares along each drawn line.</p>	
<p>Step 5. Press each pieced square open with the seam allowance placed towards the Red.</p>	
<p>Step 6. Trim the fabric points so you have a neatly finished square. Align the square "squarely" under a rotary ruler with a diagonal line, ensuring the diagonal line matches with your seam line. Then, trim them to 4 1/2" x 4 1/2". Make 18 Half Square Triangle units.</p>	

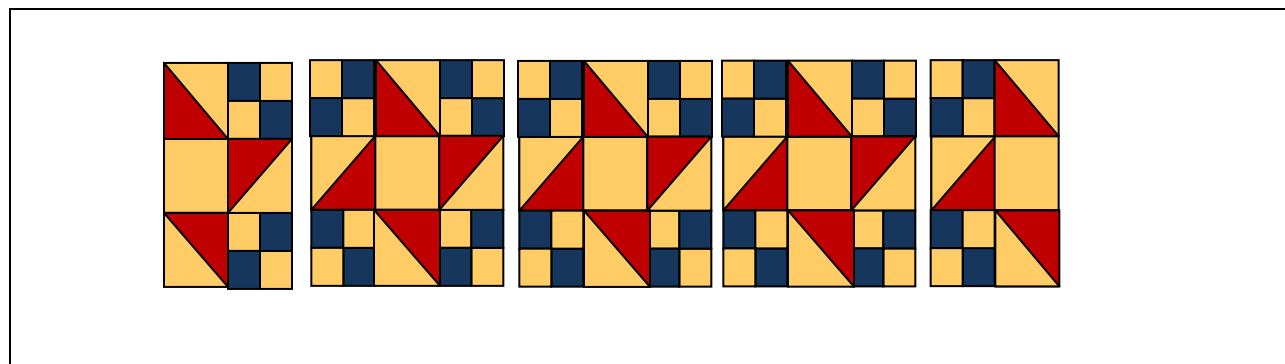
2. Four-Patch Square Unit (16 total) *See Diagram A.*

<p>Step 1. To make a strip set, sew 1—2 1/2" Cream strip to 1—2 1/2" Blue strip together along the long edge. Press toward the Blue. Make 2 strip sets.</p>
<p>Step 2. Subcut into a total of 32—2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Sew these units together to make 16—4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Four-Patch Square units. Square each unit if necessary.</p>
<p>Diagram A:</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">Make 2 strip sets. Make 16—4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Four-Patch Square units.</p> <p>Cut 16—2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles from each strip set (32 total)</p>

3. Block Assembly

<p>Top Row of block: Sew Four-Patch and Half Square Triangle units together as shown in the diagram to the right. Press towards the Four-Patch units.</p>	<p>Make 3 of each:  Make 1  Make 1 </p> 
<p>Middle Row of block: Sew Half Square Triangle units to the sides of a 4 1/2" Cream square. Press towards the center.</p>	<p>Make 3 of each:   Make 1  Make 1 </p> 
<p>Bottom Row of block: Sew Four-Patch and Half Square Triangle units together. Press towards the Four-Patch units.</p>	<p>Make 3 of each:  Make 1  Make 1 </p> 
<p>Complete Block: Sew the rows together, matching seams. Press towards the center.</p>	<p>Make 3.  Make 1.  Make 1. </p>

4. Runner Assembly: Assemble runner as shown below.



5. Finishing: Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using the 4—2 1/2" x WOF Striped strips.
