Buckaroo Panel Quilt - 1 Panel + 6 Fat Quarters + 1 Afternoon!

Finished Quilt is Approximately 47" x 61"

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This pattern was designed for a 30" wide panel. If you have a 23 1/2" panel, you will need to adjust your strips to fit.

Instructions:

- 1 Cut the 2 Blue, 1 Red, and 1 Yellow Star fat quarters into 2 - 9" x 22" pieces
- 2 From the Blue pieces, cut 16 - 9" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 3 From the Red & Yellow pieces cut 12 - 9" x 3 1/2" rectangles from each
- 4 From the Blue Badges fabric, cut 4 - 9" squares
- 5 From the Roy Rogers Rope fabric, cut 2 - 9 x 5 1/2" rectangles for the top, and 2 - 9" x 7 1/2" rectangles for the sides
- 6 Sew the side strips on first, then top and bottom with the corners
- 7 When attaching the sides, sew from the panel side so you can make sure the brown line will be visible on the front when you are through
- 8 Backing can be pieced horizontally - check for direction on your backing, as this yardage assumes that you will turn the fabric horizontally.
