EMBROIDERY BLOCK OF THE MONTH

Use your embroidery machine to make a wonderful quilt. The blocks are sewn and quilted in the hoop. This program was designed by Hoop Sisters and it's called the Crazy Compass. The blocks can be 5 or 8 inch. The first class will be one-on-one. Make your appointment and we will explain the program and discuss fabric and batting choices. Cost is \$100 for the entire program. Purchase your fabric at Marie's and get a free USB stick. Each month stop out with your stick and we will load the designs and sewing instructions on for you. It is a ten month program. If you prefer to pay by the month the cost is \$12 monthly.


OPEN SEWING TUESDAYS
