Tournament formats will be pool play in the mornings with all teams advancing to playoff brackets in the afternoons. Current USA Volleyball rules will apply with some local exceptions.

Saturday, June 23 - SpikeFest Coed Quads Rotating Pairs

Register as a coed doubles team, and you will be paired with other teams throughout pool play before being seeded into a playoff tournament based on your record.

\$40.00 by June 15/\$50.00 after.

Saturday, July 21 - Burning Mountain Blast Mixed Quads

Teams must have at least 1 female on the court at all times, and will be seeded into playoff divisions based on pool play results. \$80.00 by July 13/\$100.00 after.

Saturday, August 18 - Hot August Days Mixed Triples

Let's try a different format and play some 3 on 3 volleyball! Get your best team together and we'll battle it out until we determine a champion. \$60.00 by August 10/\$75.00 after.

Tourney Details - Check in by 9:00 a.m. at Grand River Park located on the south side of the Colorado River at I-70 and the New Castle exit. Pool play begins at 9:30 a.m. sharp! Youth teams are more than welcome at all events!

Monday Mixed Quads League (16+)

Our Mixed Quads Grass League is perfect for both recreational and competitive teams. Teams are required to have at least one female on the court at all times and this league is self-officiated.

Dates: June 11-August 6

Times: 6:30-8:00 p.m.

Cost: \$100.00 by June 1/\$120.00 after, per team.

Free Agents registration is for individuals that may be placed on a team with other Free Agents, if there are enough to do so. Fee: \$30.00

Youth Grass Volleyball Camp (Ages 8-17)

Our grass volleyball camp is coed, and is a great way for the young player to work on their skills and have fun at the same time. Participants will receive skill instruction each day, focusing on the basics of the sport (passing, setting, serving, hitting), along with fun games and scrimmages.

Monday Youth League (8-14)

This 6 week recreational coed grass league will include skill instruction each week along with scrimmage play.
