MASTERING YOUR SERGER CLASSES:

Class #1: BASIC SERGER USE - Designed to make you comfortable with your new serger, this class covers threading, tension settings, and basic serger applications.

Class #2: BASIC SERGER USE Continued - this class continues with threading and goes into different threading for special stitching.

Class #3: SERGING AHEAD - Learn to use your serger for more than seaming and finishing edges. This class explores the use of serger accessory presser feet and attachments for both embellishment and practical uses. Discover how to incorporate chain and cover stitching if your model offers these features.

MASTERING YOUR EMBROIDERY CLASSES: EMBROIDERY MACHINE BASICS

This mastery class is for embroidery machine owners. Learn the ins and outs of your BERNINA or Deco embroidery machine. From the basics of hooping to customizing designs and Endless Embroidery, You'll discover all you need to get the most from your embroidery system. You must bring your machine and embroidery unit. Aurora embroidery owners must also bring a laptop with dongle and software loaded.

MASTERING YOUR BERNINA

DESIGNER V6 SOFTWARE:

These Version 6 classes are lecture/demo. Bring your laptop and dongle. Laptops that are brought to class are the student's responsibility. The instructor cannot take time from class to deal with computer or software problems that may arise.



Class #1: Learn to calibrate screen. Discover tool bar icons; resize, rotate & mirror designs; thread matching, fabric settings, basic lettering functions, print & send designs to your machine. *Editor Plus & Designer Plus Software* (Software 1 is a prerequisite to Software 2.)

Class #2: - Utilize Portfolio, edit & auto digitize design; Remove overlaps, use magic wand & touch on Art Canvas. *Editor Plus & Designer Plus Software* (Software 1 required before taking Software 2)

Class #3: Manually digitize embroidery design; Use new V6 tools: morphing, carving stamp, outline effect, sculptured fill, star stitch, ripple stitch, stipple, contour fill, cross stitch fill & freehand drawing. *Designer Plus Software Only* (Software 1 & 2 prerequisites to Software 3)

Class #4: Learn basic Navigation of Art Canvas, the CorelDRAW Essentials 4 portion of V6. *Software: Designer Plus Only* (Software 1,2 & 3 required before
