WOW! The year is almost half over already!

NEWS FLASH!! July 30th we have a very special guest coming to Quilt'n Kaboodle! Kansas Troubles designer, Lynn Hagmeier, for Moda will be teaching a class in the morning and have a presentation in the afternoon. There is a class limit of 37. The class fee is \$35 and includes the pattern and fabric kit from a selection. The afternoon presentation and trunk show does not have a limit and the entrance cost is \$10. Lynn will tell her story of how she got started in designing, how she designs and will also have approximately 70 quilts to show. You'll be able to meet, visit and get autographs from Lynn after the afternoon presentation. This event will be held at the Cherokee Community Center in the upper level. We have a few tickets left for the morning class so let us know ASAP if you'd like to purchase one. There is no limit for Lynn's afternoon presentation and trunk show. We are steadily receiving new fabrics. All of our Christmas and fall/Halloween fabric is in! Christmas lines include: For All Seasons (snowmen) from Andover, Winterberry Lane (whimsical) from Red Rooster, Yuletide Magic (metallic reindeer) from Benartex, Merry and Bright from Buggy Barn, Winter Wishes from Benartex, Nature's Gift from Moda, and Holiday Splendor from Hoffman. Sandra Gervais's Autumn Grand Finale is here along with many other autumn fabrics and colors. Scribble Monster for Halloween is really cute, too!

We are going to launch our first challenge quilt contest! Each participant will sign up in advance and pick up their fabric pack containing 2/3 yd. of 5 different fabrics along with instructions. The cost is \$18. The packets will be available August 1. The deadline to return your finished project is Feb. 1. Our rules are that your project must be no smaller than a 96 inch perimeter and no larger than 192 inch perimeter. The participant must use at least 3 of the 5 fabrics and may add his/her own fabric—75% of the project must be of the challenge fabric. You can not show your project to anyone and when finished you will bring it to the shop in a brown paper bag with your name and info in a sealed envelope pinned to the back side. The finished projects will be displayed at Quilt'N Kaboodle and prizes will be awarded. There will be one grand prize for the best of show! Customers will do the voting. Let's get your creative juices flowing!
