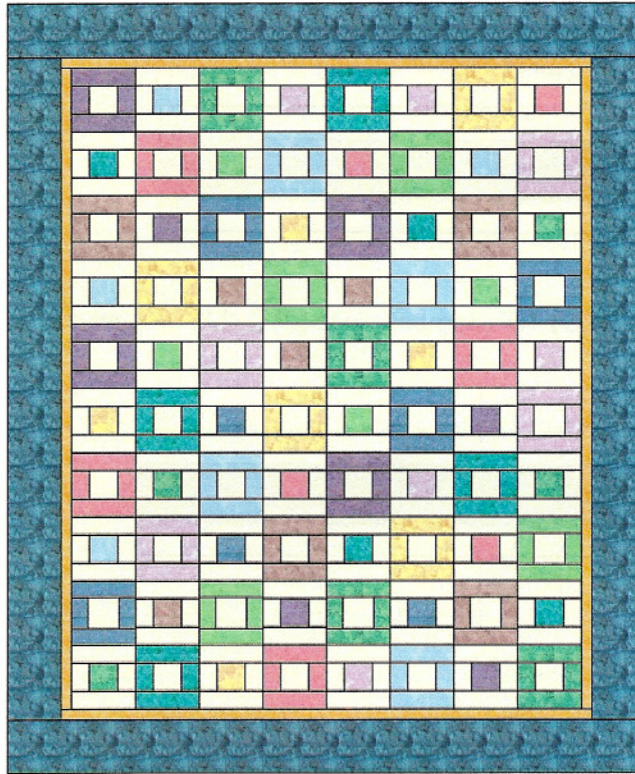


# All Squared Away

Finished size 60" x 72"

## Fabric requirements:

(10) 1/4 yards of different colors (either fat quarters or long quarters)

2 yards of background fabric that contrasts with all the colors

Inner border: 1/2 yard

Outer border: 1-1/2 yards cut cross grain, 2 yards cut lengthwise grain

Backing: 4 yards pieced crosswise, 4-1/2 yards pieced lengthwise

## From each 1/4 yard cut:

(1) 3-1/2" x 16" strip

(2) 2" x 16" strips

(8) 2" x 6-1/2" strips

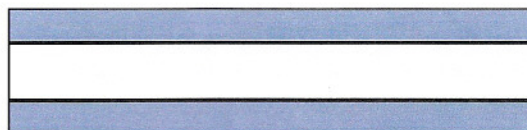
## From the background fabric cut:

(24) 2" strips- Crosscut these into (20) 2" x 16" strips

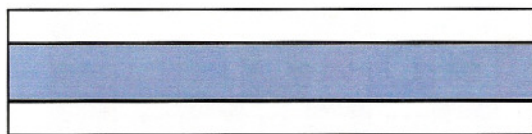
(80) 2" x 6-1/2" strips

(5) 3-1/2" strips- Crosscut these into (10) 3-1/2" x 16" strips

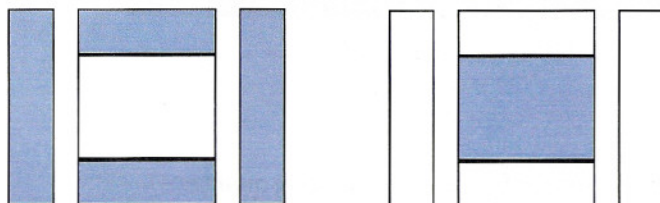
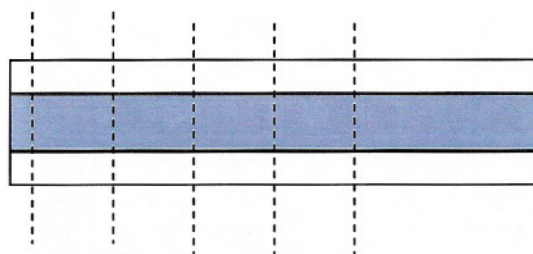
Make 16" strips sets using the 2" colored strips on the outsides and the 3-1/2" background strips in the middle. Make one using each color for a total of 10.



Make 16" strip sets using the color in the middle and the background on the outsides. Make one using each color for a total of 10.



Crosscut each of these (20) 16" strip sets into (4) 3-1/2" segments.



Add the matching 2" x 6-1/2" strips to the sides of each segment.



Make 4 blocks of each type using each of the 10 colors. (40 color blocks and 40 background blocks) Sew them into rows alternating the type of block. Place the colors randomly throughout the quilt.

Add a 1" inner border and a 5" outer border. Finished size will be approximately 60" x 72"
