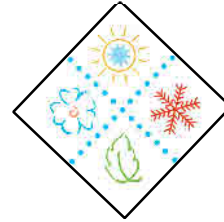

Lectures

Color Personalities

This lecture focuses on the pleasures and challenges of choosing the right fabrics, colors, patterns, etc for the project you are working on. I've been very blessed with an eye for color and I take chances with the combinations of patterns. Color is a big struggle for a lot of quilters and they need a formula - the complements that I have received have encouraged me to share with others how I go about making the choices I do. This lecture is part information and part fun - I try to include the guild group in the discussion. The fee for this lecture is \$350.00 + expenses

Designing Style

This lecture is so exciting - I enjoy teaching others how to discover their own style of quilt design. After many classes and workshops in my earlier days I finally discovered I wanted to start designing my own quilts and before I knew it I had developed a recognizable style. I have developed a lecture and workshop to encourage other quilters to jump out the nest and begin a process of discovery on the own. I love seeing the development and quilter within us all! The workshop is fun and challenging - I give them a project, but they will add their own style to finished quilt.

Modern Girl Quilting

This lecture/ group participation focuses on the importance of reaching out to modern quilters - we discuss the upcoming younger (between 22 - 48 years) quilters in the industry and the importance of including modern girls to continue the legacy of quilting. I share my inspiration, my observations, my tips to entrust the future of quilting to today's modern quilters. I share designs that lead them into the world of quilting and how everyone can contribute. This lecture is to inform and inspire the seasoned quilters and others to share themselves as part of the future of quilting as well as create a spark in new/beginner quilters.

I try to keep my all lectures light hearted with plenty of free discussion. I enjoy interacting with the group and love the feed back they often share. I am able to pull the group together as needed to ensure the discussion does not get off track or out of control. I also bring plenty of patterns for purchase at the guild meeting.

Workshops

I love to teach workshops with guild friends, it is so interesting and fun to spend the day quilting with you!! My workshops are all day classes – generally 6 hours. I prefer a minimum of 5 participants and can max at 15. If attendance goes higher than 10, there will be an additional fee of \$15 per person. Please ask for a volunteer to be an administrator and helper.

1. One day workshop - related to Modern Girl

The following projects work best with 2 or 3 choices taught simultaneously. The group likes having a choice and also they like being able to see other options. This workshop is helpful in driving home the inclusion of younger, inexperienced & new quilters. Ask your members to invite a friend who has just begun quilting or has been quilting for 1-3 years. I will not be teaching beginning basics during this workshop, so it is important that students have sewing machine and rotary cutting knowledge!

2. One day workshop - Color Personalities

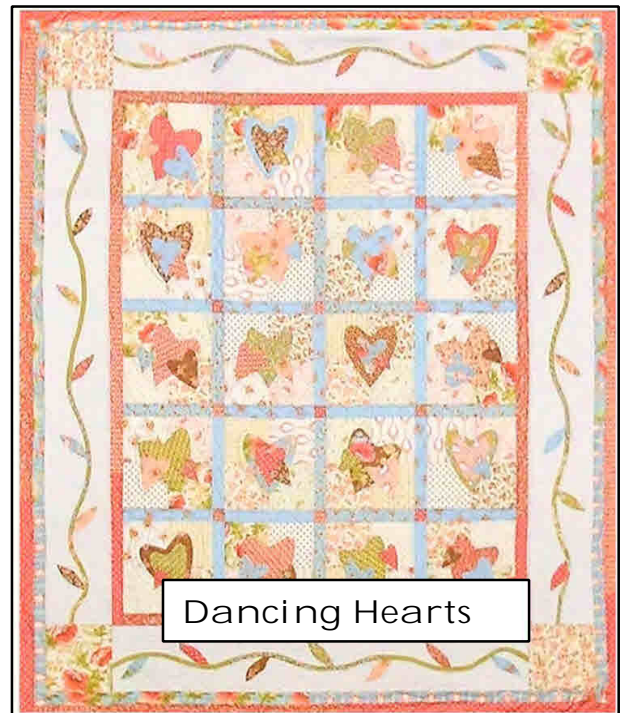

3. One day workshop - Developing Style

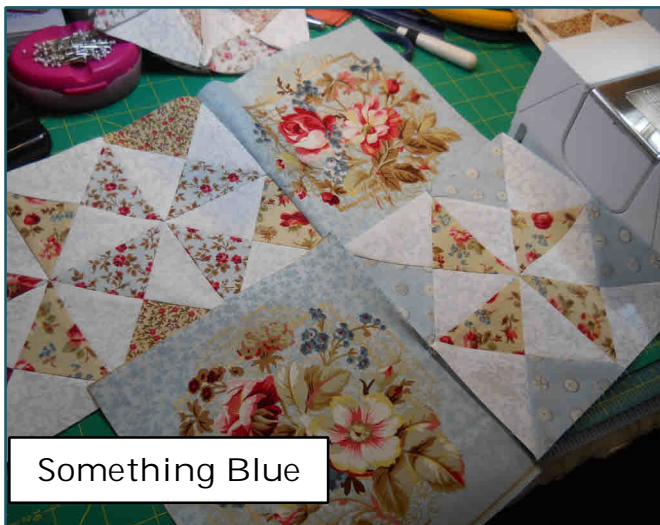

This workshop is best for intermediate to advanced students.
