Sewing Tips & Tricks

When using rulers to copy patterns, fine-tip markers often leave ink on the edge of the ruler. That means having to clean with alcohol and a cotton swab. A better solution is simply placing a piece of 3M matte-finish removable tape along the ruler's edge, the tape can be removed and it will take the ink marks with it! It comes off easily and doesn't leave a sticky residue.

THROUGH THE NEEDLE:

Choosing Presser Feet For Your Project

Most of us sew what we like, whether it is quilting, crafting, fashion, embellishment, home dec, or all of the above. The groupings below show the most often-used presser feet or groups of presser feet for each type of sewing with a brief listing of the favorite techniques for which they are used. Make sure you have what you need for the sewing tasks you do most often.

- 1. Edgestitch Foot #10/10C/10D stitching in the ditch; securing binding
- 2. Freehand Quilting Foot #29/29C freehand quilting (outline, echo, stippling, etc.)
- 3. Patchwork Foot #37 precise piecing
- 4. BERNINA Stitch Regulator BSR #42 free-motion quilting (outline, echo, stippling, etc.)
- 5. Walking Foot #50 machine-fed quilting (grid, channel, decorative stitching, etc.)
- 6. Patchwork Foot with Guide #57 precise piecing
- 7. Patchwork Foot #97/97D designed for straight-stitching and is ideal for sewing seam allowances and top stitching

CRAFTING

- 1. Jeans Foot #8 riding smoothly over varying thicknesses; penetrating heavy layers
- 2. Clear Embroidery Foot #39/39C satin stitch appliqué; couching narrow cord
- 3. BERNINA Stitch Regulator BSR #42 free-motion quilting (outline, echo, stippling, etc.)
- 4. Roller Foot #55 outline guilting; echo auiltina
- 5. Bias Binder Attachment #84 with Foot #94 - bound edges, ties

We had the annual Berry Patch party the other night and all I was asked to do was provide our home, the meat dish and the annual Rodgers Rolls. The others brought wonderful dishes to share. Over the years we have enjoyed our evening together for dinner and an ornament exchange. The one thing that has stayed constant is the Rodgers Rolls so I've renamed them Berry Patch Rolls. Several now have added them to their family traditions. My Grandmother Rodgers would be pleased.

BERRY PATCH ROLLS

1 1/2 C. Scalded milk 1 C. Sugar 1 C. Melted butter 2 pkgs. yeast 4 eggs (beaten) 1 tsp. salt 6 C. Flour Scald milk. Add sugar and salt. Cool to lukewarm. Add yeast and stir. Add half of the flour and let rise till double.

Punch down and add eggs, butter, and rest of the flour.

Refrigerate at least 3 hours or overnight.

Divide dough into two parts. Roll in a circle - 1/2" thick. Cut into 16 triangles. Roll up from the big end. Let rise - about 3 hours.

Bake at 375* for 8 minutes.

Sewing Tips & Tricks

OLIVIDAY

MONDON

To keep thread from tangling when hand-sewing with a single strand, knot the end which was last cut from the spool. For double thread, knot each end separately.

• • •

Most patterns tell you to overlap the ends of an elastic waistband when sewing them together. To eliminate bulk, some sewers butt the ends together and sew through them and a piece of ribbon. An even easier method is to butt the ends of the elastic together and sew down the seam with a wide triple-zigzag stitch. Backstitch all the way back to the starting point. This seam is virtually undetectable when the elastic is sewn into the casing.

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Attach an adhesive-backed clip to your sewing machine and clip the package of needles currently in use. It eliminates the mystery about what size needle is in the machine.
