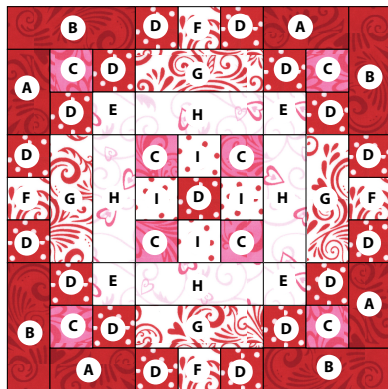


# Close to My Heart Sampler

## Full Heart



**Finished Size:**  
9" square

### Materials for a Scrappy Sampler

Make each block in the *Close to My Heart Sampler* with different light, medium, and dark prints in each block for a truly scrappy quilt. To make this block, choose scraps of the minimum size listed below for each fabric.

### Scrap Fabric Requirements

<b>Light #1</b>	20 ½" x 1 ½"
<b>Light #2</b>	6" x 1 ½"
<b>Light #3</b>	20 ½" x 1 ½"
<b>Medium #6</b>	12" x 1 ½"
<b>Dark #1</b>	25 ½" x 1 ½"
<b>Dark #3</b>	24 ½" x 1 ½"

### Cut the Pieces



- Light #1**
- E Cut 1) 6" x 1 ½" rectangle; crosscut into 4) 1 ½" segments
  - H Cut 1) 14" x 1 ½" rectangle; crosscut into 4) 3 ½" segments



- Light #2**
- I Cut 1) 6" x 1 ½" rectangle; crosscut into 4) 1 ½" segments



- Light #3**
- F Cut 1) 6" x 1 ½" rectangle; crosscut into 4) 1 ½" segments
  - G Cut 1) 14" x 1 ½" rectangle; crosscut into 4) 3 ½" segments



- Medium #6**
- C Cut 1) 12" x 1 ½" rectangle; crosscut into 8) 1 ½" segments



- Dark #1**
- D Cut 1) 25 ½" x 1 ½" rectangle; crosscut into 17) 1 ½" segments



- Dark #3**
- A Cut 1) 10" x 1 ½" rectangle; crosscut into 4) 2 ½" segments
  - B Cut 1) 14" x 1 ½" rectangle; crosscut into 4) 3 ½" segments

### Make the Block

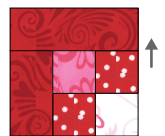
Use ¼"-wide seam allowances.

- To make a Corner Unit, sew a (C) square to the left side of a (D) square. Sew a (D) square to the left side of an (E) square. Press as directed. Join both rows as shown. Sew rectangle (A) to the left side of (C/D/D/E) and press toward darker fabric. Sew a (B) rectangle to the top of (A/C/D/D/E). Press toward (B). Repeat to make 4. Figure 1.

# Close to My Heart Sampler

2. To make the Middle Unit, sew a (D) square to both sides of an (F) square. Press toward outside. Sew (D/F/D) to the top of a (G) rectangle. Sew an (H) rectangle to the bottom of the (G) rectangle. Press both seams toward (H). Repeat to make 4. Figure 2.

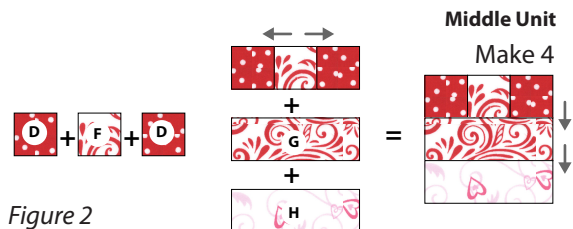

3. For the Center Unit, sew a (C) square to both side of an (I) square. Make 2. Sew an (I) square to both sides of a (D) square. Press as directed. Sew the three rows together as shown. Press toward outside. Make 1 Center Unit. Figure 3.

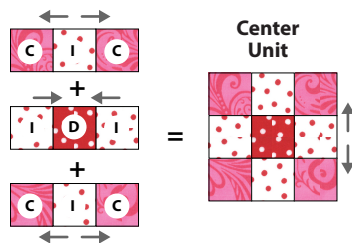

4. Sew a Corner Unit to both sides of a Middle Unit making sure to orient each unit as show. Press to outside. Make 2. Sew a Middle Unit to both sides of the Center Unit as shown. Press to inside. Join the rows to complete the block. Press toward the outside rows. Figure 4.

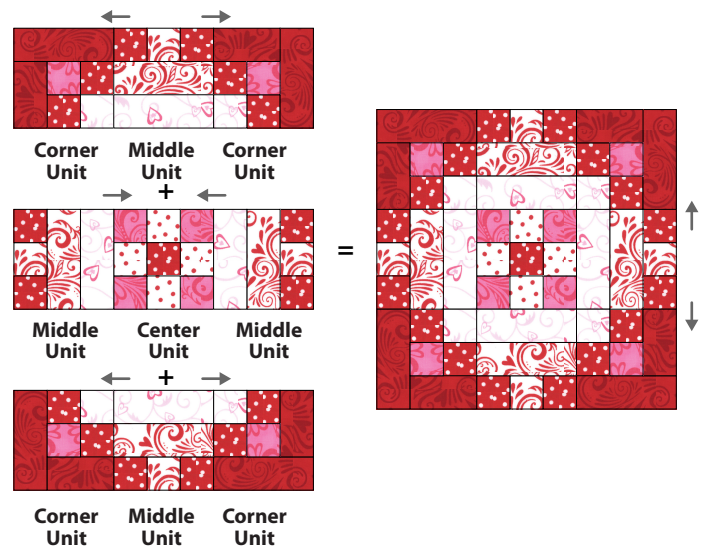
