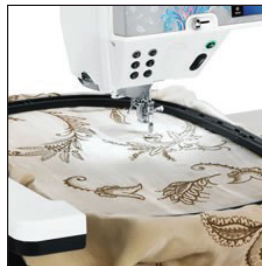

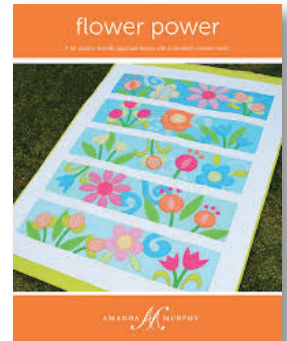

UFO RETREAT

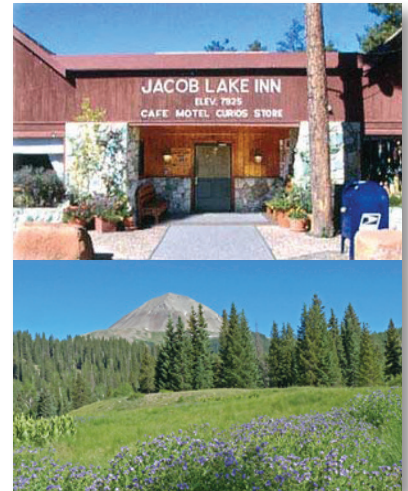
