

SPECIAL MEETING OF WILLIAMSBURG CITY COUNCIL

FEBRUARY 26,2014 WEDNESDAY, 6:40 Pm

PRESENT: NORTON, TIPTON, WORDEN
MESSICK (AT 7:00P)

PURPOSE: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT DISCUSSION

Mayor Horne opened the meeting by saying that when the 2014 budget was approved an additional amount of \$18,000 was budgeted for capital improvement. Several items were discussed :

Repairing leakage in manholes, there is some infiltration, especially after a big rain. Councilman Norton got a map and showed Councilwoman Worden the location of these as well as the location of the lift stations after she asked where these were located as well as the number. He showed the location of 29 on the north side of William street and 55 on the south side. Mr Hickman has left an estimate of \$20,000 to repair all these after an inspection of his. Those in the low lying areas need to be addressed. Councilman Tipton suggested these repairs be done in a grid pattern until all repairs were done.

Mayor Horne said other items are redoing the sidewalk on the North side of William street; adding some concrete to the parking lot on William, and chip and seal on some streets.

Councilman Messick suggested holding back some money for a big project. Jon mentioned looking into grants but the matching funding amounts is greater than what we could afford.

Mayor Horne mentioned that the Recreation Comm. has recommended a toddler play addition to the existing playground is being looked into at a cost of \$3-4 thousand. Councilwoman Worden mentioned that the playground fund being held by the old Lion's Club for Jeff Link has approximately 6-7 thousand dollars in it and should be used for this.

Mayor Horne and Councilman Norton discussed putting concrete pots on

the bandstand, painting the cannon and buffalo in the park. Councilman Tipton has found a tractor and loader that might be feasible for City use and it was decided that the machinery dealer be invited to the next council meeting(Mon, March 2,) to address this. Mayor Horne and Councilman Norton as well will go look at it Saturday.

There was general discussion on all the above issues.

Meeting adjourned at 7:35p.
